



INSIGHTS - MATCHDAY 22

SERIE A ENILIVE 2025/2026



There have been nine meetings in Milan between the two sides: Inter have won eight (most recently 6-3 in Serie A 1990/91), Pisa have won one (1-0 away in Serie A 1982/83), and there have been no draws.

The last meeting at San Siro dates back to 21 October 1990, a 6-3 Inter win. Serena scored a hat-trick, Matthäus netted twice (including a penalty), and Bergomi also scored; for Pisa, Piovaneli scored twice and there was an own goal by Stringara.

Pisa's only win away to Inter came on 6 March 1983, a 1-0 victory decided by a Giampiero Marini own goal.

Inter are the top scorers in Serie A 2025/26 with 44 goals.

Inter are among the teams with zero red cards in Serie A 2025/26, along with Cagliari, Torino and Verona.

Inter are the team that have scored the most goals in the opening 15 minutes in Serie A 2025/26 (8).

Inter are the team that have scored the most goals in the final 15 minutes (stoppage time included) in Serie A 2025/26 (10).

Pisa are the Serie A 2025/26 team to have been awarded the most penalties (6).

Pisa are the team that have conceded the most goals in the final 15 minutes of the first half in Serie A 2025/26 (7), level with Torino.

Pisa have gone 10 matchdays without a win: their last – and only – league victory this season was a 1-0 home win over Cremonese at the Cetilar Arena on 7 November; since then, they have recorded five draws and five defeats.

Pisa have not won an away match in Serie A since 24 March 1991, a 3-2 victory at Parma.

It will be the second official meeting between Cristian Chivu and Alberto Gilardino: their only previous encounter was the reverse fixture, which Inter won 2-0 away at the Cetilar Arena.

Lautaro Martínez scored against Udinese: he is now one goal away from matching his tally from last season (12).



Rafiu Durosinni scored against Atalanta: his goal came just 19 minutes into his debut in Italian football – he came on in the 68th minute and scored in the 87th.



COMO



TORINO

There have been 19 meetings in Como between the two sides: Como have won six (most recently 1-0 in last season's Serie A), there have been five draws (most recently 0-0 in Serie B 1989/90) and Torino have won eight (most recently 2-0 away in Serie B 2003/04).

Como have the highest average possession in Serie A 2025/26 (60.6%).

Only Roma (12) have conceded fewer goals in Serie A 2025/26 than Como (16), level with Milan.

Torino are one of two Serie A 2025/26 teams with no red cards at all – for or against – along with Verona.

Torino are among the teams that have conceded the most goals in Serie A 2025/26 (34), level with Verona.

Only Bologna (105, the only team to have used them all) have made more substitutions than Torino in Serie A 2025/26 (104).

Torino have been without a draw since 8 November (0-0 in the Derby della Mole against Juventus): since then they have played 11 matches, recording four wins and seven defeats.

Torino are the team that have conceded the most goals in the final 15 minutes of the first half (stoppage time included) in Serie A 2025/26 (7), level with Pisa.

It will be the fourth official meeting between Cesc Fàbregas and Marco Baroni: the previous three produced one win each and one draw, and both wins were 5-1 away. For Fàbregas, that 5-1 scoreline is both his biggest win and heaviest defeat since he started coaching in Italy.

In Serie A 2025/26, **only Lautaro Martínez (15) has been involved in more goals than Nico Paz (14).**

Nico Paz is the player who has attempted the most shots in Serie A 2025/26 (78), ahead of Moise Kean (74) and Lautaro Martínez (71).

Nico Paz has eight goals after 21 matchdays: he has surpassed his previous best tally in Serie A (6), set in 2024/25, also with Como.

Among Under-21 players, only Michael Kayode (1,918 minutes) and Tiago Gabriel (1,812) have played more league minutes than Nico Paz (1,788) across Europe's top five leagues.



FIorentINA



CAGLIARI

There have been 45 official meetings in Florence between the two sides: Fiorentina have won 31 (most recently 1-0 in Serie A 2024/25), there have been eight draws (most recently 0-0 in Serie A 2019/20) and Cagliari have won six (most recently 1-0 away in Serie A 2017/18).

Cagliari's last win in Florence was a 1-0 victory in May 2018, decided by a goal from Pavoletti.

Cagliari have gone 471 minutes without scoring at the Franchi: their last goal there was scored by Pavoletti in the 69th minute of Fiorentina-Cagliari 1-1 in October 2018 (Serie A).

Fiorentina are on their best unbeaten run of the 2025/26 season: four straight league matches without defeat (two wins and two draws). Their last loss was a 0-1 defeat at Parma on 6 January.

Fiorentina are the third-lowest team in Serie A 2025/26 for different goalscorers (8).

Cagliari are the second-highest team in Serie A 2025/26 for different goalscorers (14), behind only Juventus (16).

Cagliari are among the teams with the fewest red cards received in Serie A 2025/26 (0), along with Inter, Torino and Verona.

Cagliari are among the teams that have conceded the most goals in the opening 15 minutes in Serie A 2025/26 (5), level with Genoa, Verona, Sassuolo, Udinese and Cremonese.

It will be the first official meeting between Paolo Vanoli and Fabio Pisacane.

Rolando Mandragora scored against Bologna: he now has six league goals and has never scored as many in a single league season.

Roberto Piccoli scored against Bologna: it was his first goal since 9 November 2025 (Genoa-Fiorentina 2-2).

Giovanni Fabbian, Fiorentina's new signing: he scored his most recent goal for Bologna against Fiorentina last Sunday.

Luca Mazzitelli scored against Juventus: it was his first goal of the season, and his first in Serie A since 31 October 2024 (Como-Lazio 1-5).



In Salento, there have been 23 official matches between the two sides: Lecce have won 11 (most recently 2-1 in Serie A 2023/24), there have been four draws (most recently 0-0 in Serie A 2005/06) and Lazio have won eight (most recently 2-1 away in Serie A 2024/25).

The last four meetings in Lecce have all ended 2-1: three wins for Lecce and one for Lazio.

In the last eight meetings between Lecce and Lazio, Lecce have won four, Lazio three, with one draw.

Both teams have scored in each of the last six meetings at the Via del Mare: 11 goals for Lecce and 12 for Lazio.

Lecce are the Serie A 2025/26 team that have conceded the most goals to opposition substitutes (7).

Lecce are the lowest-scoring team in Serie A 2025/26 with 13 goals.

Lecce have taken just one point from their last six matchdays: their only draw in that run was on 3 January (Juventus-Lecce 1-1). Their last win dates back to 12 December, a 1-0 home victory over Pisa at the Via del Mare.

Lecce have not scored in Serie A for 269 minutes: their last goal was scored by Stulić in the 1st minute of Lecce-Parma 1-2.

Lecce are among the teams that have benefited from the fewest opposition red cards (0), level with Verona, Torino, Milan and Sassuolo.

Lazio are the team with the most red cards received in Serie A 2025/26 (7).

Lazio have recorded only one win in their last six matchdays (Verona-Lazio 0-1 on 11 January): six points in that spell, with three draws and two defeats.

It will be the 14th official meeting between Eusebio Di Francesco and Maurizio Sarri: Sarri leads the head-to-head with six wins to four, with three draws completing the record.

Among Under-21 players, only Michael Kayode (1,918 minutes) **has played more league minutes than Tiago Gabriel (1,812) across Europe's top five leagues.**



SASSUOLO



CREMONESE

In the 6 official precedents in Emilia no draw: 3 Neroverdi victories (latest 3-2 in Serie A 2022/23, only match before today in the top division) and 3 Lombard victories (latest 1-4 in Serie B last year).

The last two matches in Serie A between Sassuolo and Cremonese both ended with the score of 3-2: on 6 March 2023 at the Mapei, on 29 August 2025 at the Zini, in the first leg match.

Sassuolo has won only once in the last 6 matches against Cremonese (precisely the 3-2 of the 2022/23 season), against three Grigiorossi victories and two draws.

Sassuolo without victories for 7 rounds: 3 draws and 4 defeats in the period. The last victory dates back to 6 December 2025 (Sassuolo-Fiorentina 3-1 at the Mapei).

In the last 3 Neroverdi matchdays without goals scored: 348 minutes have passed since the last goal scored (Thorstvedt at 12' of Sassuolo-Parma 1-1 last 3 January).

Cremonese always scoring in Emilia: 13 total goals for the Grigiorossi in 6 matches.

Sassuolo that benefits from the lowest number of opponent expulsions in favour (0) in Serie A 2025/26, like Lecce, Torino, Verona and Milan.

Facing two of the six teams of Serie A 2025/26 that have conceded most goals in the first 15' of play (5), like Genoa, Verona, Fiorentina and Udinese.

Cremonese without victories for 7 rounds: 3 draws and 4 defeats in the period. The last Grigiorossi victory dates back to 7 December 2025 (Cremonese-Lecce 2-0 at the Zini).

Cremonese without goals for 241'; last goal scored by Vardy at 29' of Cremonese-Cagliari 2-2 last 8 January.

Between Fabio Grosso and Davide Nicola 14th official encounter: in the 13 precedents, 4 victories for the first, 6 victories for the second and 3 draws.

The last goal by Andrea Pinamonti at home with the Sassuolo jersey is dated 14 April 2024, in the 3-3 between the Neroverdi and Milan. All 4 goals of this championship in fact have been scored away.



ATALANTA



PARMA

There are 33 official matches in Bergamo between the two teams: 18 Atalanta victories (the latest 3-0 in Serie A 2020/21), 9 draws (the latest 1-1 in Serie A 2011/12) and 6 Emilian victories (the latest 2-3 in Serie A 2024/25).

Since 2014/15, in the matches between Parma and Atalanta only one victory for the Crociati: the 2-3 on the last matchday of the 2024/25 championship. Record of 8 Orobici victories and 2 draws.

In the matches between Atalanta and Parma in Serie A since 2014/15, the top scorers among the players currently in the squads of the two teams are Jacob Ondrejka and Daniel Maldini, with 2 goals each.

Atalanta without defeats in Serie A in 2026: 3 victories and 1 draw for the Nerazzurri, last defeat last 28 December (Atalanta-Inter 0-1).

Parma team that benefits from the highest number of opponent expulsions (5) in Serie A 2025/26.

Parma team of Serie A 2025/26 that sends the fewest players to score (7, like Verona).

Parma team of Serie A 2025/26 that scores fewest goals with substitute players (1), like Napoli and Udinese.

Parma with only one defeat in the last 6 matchdays (Parma-Inter 0-2 on 7 January): 9 points in the period, result of 2 victories and 3 draws.

Parma is the team that has totalled most 0-0 (5) in Serie A 2025/26. Specifically, the Ducali are coming off two goalless draws, against Napoli and Genoa. For Parma 198 minutes have passed since the last goal scored (Pellegrino at 72' of Lecce-Parma 1-2) and 269' since the last goal conceded (Stulic at 1' of Lecce-Parma 1-2).

Between Raffaele Palladino and Carlos Cuesta first official encounter.

Palladino ex of the matchday: he played for Parma 76 official matches, scoring 13 goals in two spells, from January 2011 to January 2012 and subsequently in the 2013/14 and 2014/15 seasons.

Mateo Pellegrino (50) is the player who has committed most fouls in Serie A 2025/26.



ATALANTA

Mateo Pellegrino (3) is the player who has scored most headed goals in Serie A 2025/26, like Leo Østigård.



GENOA



BOLOGNA

There are 57 official precedents between the two teams at Marassi with a record of 22 Genoa victories (the latest 2-0 in Serie A 2023/24), 18 draws (the latest 2-2 in Serie A 2024/25) and 17 Bologna victories (the latest 0-1 in Serie A 2021/22).

Since 2017/18, season of Orsolini's debut with the Bologna jersey, the number 7 of the Felsinei is the top scorer in the matches between Genoa and Bologna among the players currently in the squads of both teams, with 3 goals. Then Vitorino, Venturino and Pinamonti, with 2 each.

Genoa without defeats for 4 matchdays: 1 victory and 3 draws, last match without winning the 1-3 at the Olimpico against Roma last 29 December.

Genoa team of Serie A 2025/26 with most goals scored in the first 15' of play (5), like Cremonese, Udinese, Cagliari, Verona and Sassuolo.

Bologna team of Serie A 2025/26 with most goals scored in the last 15' of the first half (7, like Milan, Napoli and Atalanta).

Only Milan (9) scores more goals than Bologna (8) in the first 15' of the second half in Serie A 2025/26.

Bologna has obtained only one victory in the last 9 matchdays of Serie A, 2-3 in Verona on 12 January; record of 3 draws and 5 defeats.

Between Daniele De Rossi and Vincenzo Italiano 2nd official encounter after Fiorentina-Roma 2-2 in Serie A 2023/24.

Vincenzo Italiano ex of the matchday: as a player 9 appearances and no goals from January to June 2005 with the Genoa jersey.

Lorenzo Colombo at 5 goals after 21 matchdays. The Genoa striker is -1 from his seasonal goal record (6) signed in Serie B in 2021/22 with Spal and repeated in 2024/25 in Serie A with Empoli.

Leo Ostigard at 4 goals after 21 matchdays: it is his best season of his career in terms of goals.



The official precedents between the two teams in Turin are 87: record of 55 Juventus victories (the latest 1-0 in Serie A 2023/23), 23 draws (the latest 0-0 in Serie A 2024/25) and 9 Napoli victories (the latest 0-1 in Serie A 2022/23).

Juventus-Napoli was for both the first match in Serie A single round-robin: on 6 October 1929 Bianconeri victory in Turin 3-2 with own goal by Zoccola (the first ever in the history of the tournament), Cevenini III and Munerati for the Bianconeri, Azzurri brace by Mihalic.

Napoli without goals in the last two matches away at Juventus: the last signed by Raspadori at 90' in the match won 0-1 in Serie A 2022/23.

In the matches between Juventus and Napoli in Serie A since 2015/16, the top scorer among the players currently in the squads of the two teams is Rasmus Hojlund, with the 2 goals scored in the first leg match.

Juventus team of Serie A 2025/26 that sends most players to score (16).

Napoli team of Serie A 2025/26 that concedes most penalties (6, like Milan and Udinese).

Napoli team of Serie A 2025/26 with fewest goals scored with substitute players (1, like Udinese and Parma).

Napoli team of Serie A 2025/26 with most goals scored in the last 15' of the first half including stoppage time (7, like Atalanta, Bologna and Milan).

Napoli without defeats for 9 official matches, record of 5 victories and 4 draws. Last defeat in Udine 1-0 last 14 December in Serie A.

Between Luciano Spalletti and Antonio Conte 2nd official encounter: in the only precedent, the first leg match, victory 2-1 for the Napoli coach.

Luciano Spalletti ex of the matchday: coach of the Azzurri in 2022/23 and in 2023/24, he won in the second year the third scudetto in the history of the Neapolitan club. In total, 96 official benches with a record of 62 victories, 17 draws and 17 defeats.



Antonio Conte ex of the matchday: Bianconeri player from 1991 to 2004, with 295 appearances and 29 goals in Serie A; in the trophy cabinet are counted 5 championships, 1 Coppa Italia, 4 Italian Supercoppa, 1 Champions League, 1 Uefa Cup, 1 Uefa Supercup, 1 Intercontinental Cup. Conte also coached Juventus, from 2011/12 to 2013/14: 102 victories, 34 draws and 15 defeats in 151 official benches, winning 3 scudetti in a row and 2 Italian Supercoppa.

Stanislav Lobotka on target against Sassuolo: the Slovak player had not scored in Serie A since 15 August 2022 in Verona-Napoli 2-5.



ROMA



MILAN

There are 99 official precedents between the two teams in Rome with a record of 31 Giallorossi victories (the latest 3-1 in Serie A 2024/25), 35 draws (the latest 1-1 in Serie A 2022/23) and 33 Milan victories (the latest 1-2 in Serie A 2022/23).

In the last 8 matches in Rome both teams always scoring: 12 Giallorossi goals, 11 Rossoneri ones.

Roma team of Serie A 2025/26 with fewest goals conceded with 12 goals.

Milan team of Serie A 2025/26 that gains most points in the second half compared to the results of the first half of play: +13. Roma is second together with Juventus (+10 for both).

Milan team of Serie A 2025/26 that concedes most penalties against (6, like Napoli and Udinese). None so far whistled against Roma.

Milan team of Serie A 2025/26 with most goals scored in the last 15' of the first half (7, like Napoli, Bologna and Atalanta).

Milan team of Serie A 2025/26 with most goals scored in the first 15' of the second half (9).

In the 2025/26 season, considering the top 5 European leagues, Milan is the team with the longest unbeaten streak (20).

Between Gian Piero Gasperini and Massimiliano Allegri 31st official encounter. In the 30 precedents, 14 victories for the current Milan coach, 6 for the former Atalanta one and 10 draws.

Milan team of Serie A 2025/26 that makes fewest substitutions (78) and that records most goals with substitute players (6).

Paulo Dybala has recorded 13 goal participations against Milan in Serie A. Only against Udinese has he recorded more (21).

After the assist in the first leg match, Leao could participate in a goal in both matches against Roma in the league for the second time after the 2022/23 season.



There are 35 official precedents between the two teams in Veneto with a record of 16 Verona victories (the latest 1-0 in Serie A 2023/24), 13 draws (the latest 0-0 in Serie A 2024/25) and 6 Udinese victories (the latest 1-2 in Serie A 2022/23).

Udinese has scored at the Bentegodi 2 goals in the last 6, both in the victory 1-2 in Serie A on 3 October 2022 (goals from Beto at 70' and Bijol at 90').

Verona without victories since last 14 December, 1-2 in Florence. In the subsequent 6 matchdays record of 2 draws and 4 Veneto defeats.

Verona team of Serie A 2025/26 that sends fewest players to score (7, like Parma).

Verona team of Serie A 2025/26 that loses in the second half most points compared to the results at 45' (-10).

Verona one of the two teams of Serie A 2025/26 without expulsions neither for nor against (together with Torino).

Verona team of Serie A 2025/26 that concedes most goals in the final 15' of play (12), including stoppage time.

Facing two of the 6 teams of Serie A 2025/26 that concede most goals in the first 15' of play (5) like Sassuolo, Cremonese, Cagliari and Genoa.

Udinese team of Serie A 2025/26 that concedes most goals in the first 15' of the second half (6).

Udinese team of Serie A 2025/26 that concedes most penalties against (6, like Napoli and Milan).

Udinese team of Serie A 2025/26 that scores least with substitutes (1, like Napoli and Parma).

Udinese with only one victory in the last 6 matchdays, the victory 1-2 away at Torino last 7 January; 2 draws and 3 Friulian defeats in the other 5.

Between Paolo Zanetti and Kosta Runjaic 4th official encounter: in the 3 precedents, 1 victory for the Scaligero coach and 2 draws.

Oumar Solet (153) is the player of Serie A 2025/26 who recovers most balls.
