



# INSIGHTS - MATCHDAY 35

SERIE A 2025/2026



**Inter have a second opportunity to win the Scudetto:** the Nerazzurri can clinch their 21st title with a win against Parma; in the event of a draw against the Ducali, Inter would be champions if Napoli fail to beat Como. Finally, in the event of a defeat, Inter would celebrate if Napoli lose to Como and Milan fail to win against Sassuolo.

It was on 3 May 1953 that Inter clinched their 6th Scudetto mathematically, beating Palermo 3-0 at San Siro. The title was won on matchday 31 of the 34 scheduled.

Since Serie A returned to a 20-team format, the last time the title was mathematically awarded at the end of matchday 35 was in 2015/16: it was won by Juventus, who won 1-2 in Florence before Napoli's defeat against Roma (1-0 at the Olimpico).

**Napoli are one step away from mathematically securing their place in the 2026/27 Champions League:** the Partenopei would qualify for Europe's premier competition with a win against Como, provided Roma fail to beat Fiorentina. It would be Napoli's 13th participation in their history across the European Cup and Champions League.

**Verona and Pisa are on the brink of relegation:** should Lecce beat Pisa in Friday evening's early kick-off, both sides would be mathematically relegated to Serie B.



**There have been 19 previous meetings between the two sides in Pisa:** 12 wins for the Nerazzurri (most recent 1-0, Serie B 2021/22), 4 draws (most recent 1-1, Serie B 2007/08) and 3 wins for the Salento side (most recent 0-1, Serie B 2020/21).

The last Serie A match between the two sides at the Arena dates back to 16 September 1990, a 4-0 win for the Tuscan side with goals from Simeone, Piovanelli (brace) and Padovano.

**Pisa are coming off the back of five consecutive defeats;** their last positive result was a 3-1 home win over Cagliari on 15 March.

**Pisa** are the 2025/26 Serie A side **that have conceded the most goals (61).**

**Lecce are coming off the back of six consecutive matches without a win:** two points during that run against four defeats. Their last victory was on 8 March (Lecce 2-1 Cremonese).

**Lecce are the 2025/26 Serie A side who have scored the fewest goals (22).** In the last two seasons, the side who scored the fewest goals in the league still managed to avoid relegation (Lecce again in the 2024/25 season with 27 goals, and Empoli in the 2023/24 season with 29).

Facing the two 2025/26 Serie A teams **that have conceded the most goals from opposing substitutes:** 12 for Pisa, 11 for Lecce (the same as Verona).

**Lecce** is the 2025/26 Serie A team that **takes the fewest penalties** (2, the same as Cagliari and Parma).

**This is the first official meeting between Oscar Hiljemark and Eusebio Di Francesco.**

Only Federico Dimarco (295), Emanuele Valeri (237) and Aaron Martín (196) **have delivered more crosses than Samuele Angori (182) in the 2025/26 Serie A season.**

**Konan N'Dri** is the 2025/26 Serie A player who **comes on as a substitute most often during a match** (23 times, the same as Amin Sarr).

Only Victor Nelsson (148) **wins more aerial duels than Tiago Gabriel (138) and Idrissa Touré (135) in the 2025/26 Serie A season.**

**No one makes more interceptions than Ylber Ramadani (178) in the 2025/26 Serie A season.**

**There have been 40 previous official matches between the two sides in Friuli:** Udinese have won 16 (the last a 2-0 victory in the 2021/22 Serie A season), 15 draws (the last a 2-2 draw, Serie A 2024/25) and 9 wins for Torino (the last a 0-2 victory in Serie A 2023/24).

**Udinese** are the Serie A 2025/26 side who **have scored the fewest goals from substitutes** (2, level with Verona).

**Udinese are coming off the back of three home games without a win:** their last victory was on 2 March (Udinese 3-0 Fiorentina). Since then, they have recorded one draw and two defeats without scoring.

Only Roma (7) and Napoli (5) **have scored more penalties than Udinese (5) in the 2025/26 Serie A season.**

Facing off at the Bluenergy Stadium are **the two teams that have conceded the most goals between the 46th and 60th minutes** in the 2025/26 Serie A season: 10 for Udinese, 9 for Torino (along with five other teams).

**Torino** are the team in the 2025/26 Serie A season that **have conceded the most goals in the first half** (27, the same as Cremonese).

**Torino** are the 2025/26 Serie A side with **the fewest different goalscorers** (10, the same as Verona).

**Torino are on a run of four matches without defeat:** their last defeat was on 21 March (Milan 3-2 Torino). Overall, under D'Aversa's management, the Granata have recorded 4 wins, 2 draws and just 2 defeats in 8 matches.

**Torino have gone 214 minutes without conceding a goal;** the last goal conceded came in the 56th minute of the Milan v Torino 3-2 match on 21 March (goal by Fofana).

**Torino** are one of two teams in the 2025/26 Serie A **without a red card awarded in their favour after 35 matchdays** (along with Milan).

**Torino** are the team in the 2025/26 Serie A that **wins the most aerial duels on average (38.8).**

Only Verona (11.6) and Roma (11.5) **win more aerial duels on average in Torino's defensive half (11.1) in the 2025/26 Serie A season.**

**Second official meeting between Kosta Runjaic and Roberto D'Aversa:** 1 win and 1 draw in favour of the Bianconeri manager

**Arthur Atta on the scoresheet twice against Lazio:** his 5th goal of the campaign, with 3 in his last 3 matches. It is also his first professional career brace.

**Giovanni Simeone on the scoresheet against Inter:** his 10th goal of the campaign, with 5 in his last 8 matches.



**The head-to-head record between the two sides at the Sinigaglia stands at 17 meetings:** 4 Lariani wins (the most recent 2-1, Serie A 2024/25), 8 draws (the most recent 0-0, Serie A 1987/88) and 5 Partenopei victories (the most recent 0-2, Serie B 2001/02).

**Como are 1 win away from their all-time record for victories in a single Serie A season:** they have claimed 17 so far, with the record standing at 18, set in 1950/51. Their all-time points record, however, has already been surpassed (61, compared to the 58 they would have accumulated in 1950/51, had a win been worth 3 points).

Only Milan (27) **concede fewer goals than Como (28)** in the 2025/26 Serie A season.

Only Roma (10) **concede fewer first-half goals than Como (12)** in the 2025/26 Serie A season.

Only Inter (80) **score more goals than Como (59)** in the 2025/26 Serie A season.

Only Inter (19) and Juventus (13) **score more headed goals than Como (10, level with Cagliari)** in the 2025/26 Serie A season.

Only Inter (13%) have a better **shot-to-goal conversion rate than Como (12%)** in the 2025/26 Serie A season.

**Como are the 2025/26 Serie A side that concedes the fewest xGA (34.4).**

**Napoli are the 2025/26 Serie A side with the most different goalscorers (19).**

**Napoli are the 2025/26 Serie A side that has conceded the most penalties (9).**

**Napoli are the 2025/26 Serie A side that receives the fewest yellow cards (43).**

Only Inter (24) and Genoa (16) **score more set-piece goals than Napoli (15)** in the 2025/26 Serie A season.

Only Inter (38) and Milan (35) **have earned more away points than Napoli and Como (29)** in the 2025/26 Serie A season.

Only Inter (12) and Milan (9) **score more goals from outside the penalty area than Napoli and Como (8, level with Genoa)** in the 2025/26 Serie A season.

**Fourth official meeting between Cesc Fabregas and Antonio Conte:** one win apiece and two draws.



**Anastasios Douvikas scores against Genoa:** his 12th goal of the season. The Como striker hadn't scored since 22 March (Como v Pisa, 5-0).

**Scott McTominay scored against Cremonese:** his 9th goal in this league campaign. The Scot has scored a total of 2 goals in his last 3 Serie A matches.

**There have been 57 previous official matches between the two sides in Bergamo:** Atalanta have won 25 (most recently 4-0, Coppa Italia 25/26), 17 draws (most recently 0-0, Serie A 2021/22) and Genoa have won 15 (most recently 0-2, Serie A 2015/16).

**Genoa can secure mathematical safety this weekend:** the Rossoblù are 11 points clear of third-bottom Cremonese, and the gap must not be reduced to nine points (which is the total number of points still up for grabs after this weekend's fixtures).

**Genoa have not won in Bergamo since 10 January 2016,** a 0-2 defeat in Serie A, with goals from Dzemaili and Pavoletti.

Only Inter (16) and Sassuolo (8) **have scored more goals from corners than Atalanta** (7, the same as Roma and Napoli) in the 2025/26 Serie A season.

Only Inter (74.3) and Juventus (63.2) **generate more xG than Atalanta (62.2) in the 2025/26 Serie A season.**

**Genoa** are the team in the 2025/26 Serie A season who **have conceded the most goals from set-pieces (19).**

Only Udinese (10) **have conceded more goals in the first 15 minutes of the second half than Genoa** (9, the same as Fiorentina, Cagliari, Como, Torino and Pisa) in the 2025/26 Serie A season.

**Third official meeting between Daniele De Rossi and Raffaele Palladino:** in the two previous encounters, one win apiece.

**Raffaele Palladino, the match's former player:** played 82 official matches for Genoa, scoring 7 goals, from July 2008 to January 2011 and from January 2017 to January 2018.

Only Moise Kean (15) and Lautaro Martinez (13.5) **have produced more xG than Nikola Krstovic (13) in the 2025/26 Serie A season.**

**Lorenzo Colombo** is the Serie A 2025/26 **player substituted most often during a match (26).**

Only Mateo Pelegrino (5) **has scored more headed goals than Leo Østigård** (4, the same as Lautaro Martinez and Marcus Thuram) in Serie A 2025/26.

**Gianluca Scamacca scores against Cagliari:** his 10th goal of the season. The Atalanta striker had not scored since 7 March 2026 (Atalanta 2-2 Udinese).

**The official head-to-head record between the two sides in Emilia stands at 39 meetings:** 21 Bologna wins (the most recent 2-1, Serie A 2024/25), 10 draws (the most recent 1-1, Serie A 2019/20) and 8 Cagliari victories (the most recent 0-1, Serie A 2009/10).

**Bologna have won 5 consecutive home matches against the Sardinians.** Cagliari's last positive result at the Dall'Ara dates back to 1 July 2020 (1-1 in Serie A, goals from Barrow for the hosts and Simeone for the visitors). Their last win in Emilia dates back to 10 January 2010 (0-1 with a decisive goal from Matri).

**Bologna are the 2025/26 Serie A side that makes the most substitutions** (169 out of 170 available).

**Bologna are the 2025/26 Serie A side that is caught offside the most times** (67, level with Atalanta).

**Bologna are the 2025/26 Serie A side that wins the most ground duels per match (20).**

**Bologna are the 2025/26 Serie A side that completes the most long passes per match (52.8).**

**Only Lazio (7) have received more red cards** in the 2025/26 Serie A season **than Bologna (6).**

**Bologna have gone 270 minutes without scoring in official matches:** the last goal, scored by Orsolini, dates back to 12 April 2026 in the 90th minute of Bologna 2-0 Lecce, Serie A.

**Cagliari are one of 3 sides** in the 2025/26 Serie A season **that have taken the fewest penalties** (2, level with Lecce and Parma).

**Cagliari are the 2025/26 Serie A side that concedes the most goals from open-play crosses** (12, level with Pisa).

**Cagliari are the 2025/26 Serie A side that makes the most defensive recoveries per match** (38.6, level with Verona).

Only Inter (12) **score more goals through substitutes** in the 2025/26 Serie A season **than Cagliari** (10, level with Atalanta and Juventus).

**Cagliari have suffered 4 defeats in their last 5 away matches.** Their only positive result dates back to 27 February 2026 (Parma 1-1 Cagliari, Serie A).

**The second official meeting between Vincenzo Italiano and Fabio Pisacane** following Bologna's victory in the first leg on 19 October 2025.

**No player has hit the woodwork more times (7) than Riccardo Orsolini** in Serie A 2025/26.

**No player has been fouled more times (105) than Marco Palestra** in Serie A 2025/26.

**Paul Mendy scores against Atalanta:** first goal and first brace in Serie A for the Cagliari striker. Paul Mendy is the third player born in 2007 to score a brace in the top five European leagues currently underway, after Lamine Yamal and Robinio Vaz.

**The official head-to-head record between the two sides in Emilia stands at 11 meetings: 3** Neroverdi wins (the most recent 2-0, Serie A 2015/16), 2 draws (the most recent 3-3, Serie A 2023/24) and 6 Rossoneri victories (the most recent 0-3, Serie A 2021/22).

**Two fixtures stand out in the history of their meetings on Emilian soil:** the very first, on 12 January 2014, a 4-3 home win featuring a Domenico Berardi four-goal haul – the last match of Allegri's first spell at Milan – and the one on 22 May 2022, a 3-0 Rossoneri victory on the final matchday that sealed Milan's 19th league title, with goals from Giroud – a brace – and Kessié.

**Sassuolo have gone without a home draw since 3 January (1-1 against Parma).** In the subsequent 8 home matches, 5 wins and 3 defeats.

**Sassuolo** are the 2025/26 Serie A side that **concedes the most goals in the opening 15 minutes of the first half (10).**

**Only Cremonese (5.3) concede more shots on target per match** in the 2025/26 Serie A season **than Sassuolo (5).**

**Milan** are the 2025/26 Serie A **side with the highest successful forward pass percentage (78.3%).**

**Milan** are the 2025/26 Serie A side that **earns the most points from losing positions (14).**

**Milan (27)** are the 2025/26 Serie A side that **concedes the fewest goals.**

**Milan** are the 2025/26 Serie A side that **makes the fewest substitutions** (137 out of 170 available).

**Milan** are the 2025/26 Serie A side that **earns the most points in the second half compared to half-time standings** (+15, level with Juventus).

**This is the 2nd official meeting between Fabio Grosso and Massimiliano Allegri:** the only previous encounter was the first leg (2-2 at the Meazza).

**Massimiliano Allegri is a former manager of today's hosts:** he led the Neroverdi in the 2007/08 season in Serie C1, accumulating 42 matches on the bench with a record of 22 wins, 7 draws and 13 defeats, achieving the historic promotion to Serie B and winning the Serie C1 Supercoppa.

**No player touches the ball more in the attacking half (1,289) than Luka Modrić in the 2025/26 Serie A season.**

**Arijanet Muric is the Serie A player in the 2025/26 season who has made the most saves from shots inside the penalty area (79).**



**There have been 42 official matches between the two sides in Turin:** Juventus have won 35 (most recently 2-0 in the 2024/25 Serie A season), there have been 6 draws (most recently 1-1 in the 2020/21 Serie A season) and one win for the Gialloblù (0-1 in the 1962/63 Coppa Italia).

**Verona's only win at Juventus dates back to 3 April 1963,** a 0-1 victory in the Coppa Italia, with Maioli scoring in the 90th minute.

**Juventus are on a run of 40 consecutive positive results in all competitions against Verona at home:** 34 wins and 6 draws, with 88 goals scored and 21 conceded.

**Juventus are on a run of eight consecutive positive results in all competitions against Verona** (at the Allianz Stadium and the Bentegodi): a record of six wins and two draws. Their last defeat was a 2-1 loss in Veneto on 30 October 2021.

**Juventus are on a run of four consecutive clean sheets against Verona at home:** the last goal scored by the Gialloblù at the Bianconeri's home ground came in the 60th minute of the 1-1 draw between Juventus and Verona on 25 October 2020, scored by Andrea Favilli. Since then, the Scaligeri have gone 390 minutes without scoring.

**Since the 2015/16 season, the top scorer in matches between Juventus and Verona** (at the Allianz Stadium and the Bentegodi) is Dusan Vlahovic, with 4 goals (level with Paulo Dybala).

**Juventus are on a run of 4 consecutive clean sheets:** this is their best run in this Serie A campaign. To find a better run in the league, one has to go back to August–October 2024, with six clean sheets. Furthermore, the Bianconeri have kept a clean sheet for 398 minutes, the last goal conceded coming from Andrea Pinamonti in the 52nd minute of the Juventus v Sassuolo 1-1 draw on 21 March.

**Juventus fail to score against Milan:** the Bianconeri have ended a run of seven consecutive matches scoring in Serie A (the last time they failed to score was in the Juventus 0-2 Como match on 21 February). For the Turin side, this was their second-best run in this league campaign (surpassed only by the period between November 2025 and January 2026, when they scored in nine consecutive matches).

Only Inter (159) **make more passes on average in Juventus' attacking third (145) in the 2025/26 Serie A season.**

**Juventus** are the 2025/26 Serie A side **that attempt the most dribbles on average (16.9).**



Since **Luciano Spalletti's arrival** (Matchday 10, Cremonese v Juventus), **Juventus are the 2025/26 Serie A side with the fewest goals conceded** (20, level with Inter and Milan).

**Juventus are the 2025/26 Serie A side who have gained the most points in the second half compared to their first-half results** (+15, the same as Milan), while Verona are the side who have lost the most (-12).

**Verona are the 2025/26 Serie A side with the fewest different players to have scored** (10, like Torino) and the fewest goals scored by substitutes (2, like Udinese).

**Verona have scored just 1 goal in their last 6 Serie A matches** (Torino 2-1 Verona on 11 April): they have equalled their own worst run of this season, set between August and October 2025 (also 1 goal in 6 matches, between matchdays 2 and 7).

**Verona are the 2025/26 Serie A side with the lowest percentage of shots converted into goals (5.9%).**

**Amin Sarr** is the 2025/26 Serie A player who **comes on as a substitute most often during a match** (23 times, the same as Konan N'Dri).

**This is the first official meeting between Luciano Spalletti and Paolo Sammarco.**

Only Santiago Pierotti (129) and Morten Frentrup (124) **make more tackles than Manuel Locatelli (114) in the 2025/26 Serie A season.**

**Gift Orban ranks 6th in the 2025/26 Serie A among players who generate the most xG (11.5)**, behind Moise Kean (14.98), Lautaro Martinez (13.5), Nikola Krstovic (13.3), Rasmus Hojlund (12.9) and Marcus Thuram (11.8).



**There have been 33 official matches between the two sides in Milan:** the Nerazzurri have won 18 (most recently 3-1 in the 2024/25 Serie A season), there have been 12 draws (most recently 2-2 in the 2020/21 Serie A season) and the Crociati have won three (most recently 0-1 in the 2018/19 Serie A season).

**The clash between Inter and Parma could decide the Scudetto for the second time in the Nerazzurri's history:** the previous occasion dates back to 18 May 2008, the final matchday of the 2007/08 Serie A season, when Parma lost 0-2 to Inter at the Tardini thanks to a brace from Zlatan Ibrahimovic. The Ducali were condemned to their first-ever relegation to Serie B.

**Inter have won just once in their last seven home matches against Parma:** a 3-1 victory on 6 December 2024 in Serie A. The record is completed by five draws (including one in the 90th minute, with a 2-1 win in extra time in the 2022/23 Coppa Italia) and one defeat.

**Inter have conceded in seven consecutive home matches against Parma:** the Nerazzurri's last clean sheet dates back to 21 April 2013, Inter 1-0 Parma.

**Inter are on a run of nine consecutive positive results in all competitions against Parma:** five wins and four draws (including one in the 90th minute, with a 2-1 victory in extra time in the 2022/23 Coppa Italia).

Since the 2015/16 season, **among the players currently in the Inter and Parma squads, the top scorers in matches** (at San Siro and the Tardini) **are Marcus Thuram and Federico Dimarco, with three goals each.**

**Inter are on a run of 7 consecutive positive results** (4 wins, 3 draws and 19 goals scored): their last defeat was on 8 March, Milan 1-0 Inter.

**Inter** are the 2025/26 Serie A side with **the most goals scored by substitutes (12).**

**Inter are the 2025/26 Serie A side with the most goals scored in the first 15 minutes of matches** (11, alongside Como and Juventus), in the final 15 minutes of the first half (12, alongside Milan), in the first 15 minutes of the second half (14) and in the final 15 minutes (18).

**Facing the team with the fewest red cards received** (Inter, 0) and the team with the most red cards received (Parma, 7) in the 2025/26 Serie A season.

Facing the two teams in the 2025/26 Serie A **season that attempt the most crosses from set-pieces (Inter 271 and Parma 264).**



**Parma are the team in the 2025/26 Serie A season who have taken the fewest penalties (2, alongside Cagliari and Lecce).**

**Parma have kept a clean sheet for 210 minutes:** the last goal they conceded came in the 60th minute of the 1-1 draw between Parma and Napoli on 12 April, scored by McTominay.

**Parma are on a run of four consecutive positive results (two wins and two draws):** this is their second-best run in this league (surpassed only by a run of five between February and March 2026).

**Second official meeting between Cristian Chivu and Carlos Cuesta:** in their only previous encounter, the first-leg fixture, the Nerazzurri manager secured a 2-0 victory at the Tardini.

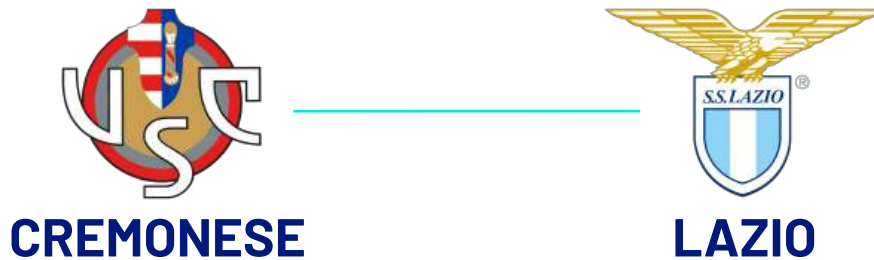
**Cristian Chivu is the match's former player:** he managed Parma for 13 matches last season, recording 3 wins, 7 draws and 3 defeats, and securing survival at the end of the season.

**Ange-Yoan Bonny is the former player of the day:** he wore the Parma shirt 117 times, scoring 15 goals and winning the 2023/24 Serie B title. It is the club for which he has made the most appearances at professional level.

**Marcus Thuram scores against Torino:** the Nerazzurri striker's 12th goal in this league campaign. Behind Donyell Malen (11) and level with Nikola Krstovic, he is the second-highest scorer (8) in Serie A for the 2026 calendar year. This is also the Frenchman's second-best season of his career in terms of goals (17) across all competitions: his record stands at 18, set in 2024/25, again with Inter.

**Gaetano Oristanio, the match's former player:** he came through the Nerazzurri youth ranks from 2016 to 2021, though he never made an appearance for the first team.

**Nesta Elphege on target against Pisa:** the French striker's second goal in Serie A. He hadn't scored in consecutive competitive matches since November 2025 (Amiens 2-3 Grenoble and Grenoble 2-1 Rodez, Ligue 2).



**The head-to-head record between the two sides in Cremona stands at 13 meetings:** 5 Grigiorossi wins (the most recent 2-1, Serie A 1995/96), 5 draws (the most recent 0-0, Serie A 1994/95) and 3 Lazio victories (the most recent 0-4, Serie A 2022/23).

**Cremonese have gone 9 home matches without a win:** their last victory was on 7 December 2025, Cremonese 2-0 Lecce. Since then, 4 draws and 5 defeats.

**Cremonese have gone 270 minutes without scoring:** the last goal was scored by Bonazzoli from the penalty spot in the 91st minute of Cremonese 1-2 Bologna on 5 April.

**Only 5 of the 96 sides competing in the top 5 European leagues have scored fewer goals than Cremonese's 26 this season:** Parma, Pisa, Wolverhampton, Verona and Lecce.

**Cremonese are the 2025/26 Serie A side that plays the fewest balls in the opposition penalty area** (12.1 per match).

**Only Bologna (80.5) average more long passes per match than Cremonese (68.8) in the 2025/26 Serie A season.**

**Lazio are the 2025/26 Serie A side with the most red cards received (7).**

**Only Milan (26.6) win fewer duels on average than Lazio (26.7) in the 2025/26 Serie A season.**

**This is the 9th official meeting between Marco Giampaolo and Maurizio Sarri:** across the previous 8 encounters, 6 wins for the Lazio manager and 2 draws.

**Only Tarik Muharemović (87) has made more clearances with his feet than Federico Baschiroto (81) in the 2025/26 Serie A season.**

Only Marcus Thuram (4), Evan Ndicka (3), Lautaro Martínez (3) and Christian Kabasele (3) have scored **more goals from corners than Federico Baschiroto (2).**

**Alessio Romagnoli is the 2025/26 Serie A player with the highest number of passes attempted in the defensive half (1,498).**

**Alessio Romagnoli is the 2025/26 Serie A defender with the highest number of forward passes attempted (907).**

**There have been 100 previous official matches between the two sides in Rome:** the Giallorossi have won 49 (the last a 1-0 victory in the 2024/25 Serie A season), there have been 32 draws (the last a 1-1 draw in the 2023/24 Serie A season) and Fiorentina have won 19 (the last a 0-2 victory in the 2017/18 Serie A season).

**Roma have not lost at home in Serie A since Roma v Napoli (0-1, Neres) on 30 November 2025.** Since that match, the Giallorossi have recorded seven wins and three draws at the Olimpico.

**Roma have scored in 13 consecutive home matches, netting a total of 27 goals.** Their last goalless match dates back to 30 November 2025 (Roma v Napoli 0-1, Serie A).

**Roma** are the 2025/26 Serie A side **conceding the fewest penalties (1).**

Only Inter (141) and Genoa (112) **have recorded more shots from set pieces than Roma (110).**

**Roma are the Serie A side who have conceded the fewest goals in the opening stages of matches (10).** If only first halves were counted, Roma would be 4th in the table with 56 points.

**Taking only the second half of the season into account, Roma and Fiorentina are separated by just one point in the table:** the Giallorossi on 25 points, the Tuscan side on 24, in 6th and 8th place respectively in this special table.

**Fiorentina are coming off the back of seven consecutive positive results in Serie A** (three wins and four draws). Their last league defeat dates back to 2 March 2026 (Udinese 3-0 Fiorentina, Serie A).

**Fiorentina** are the Serie A side who **have conceded the most headed goals (13).**

**Fiorentina** are the Serie A side who **have dropped the most points from leading positions (24).**

**Third official meeting between Gian Piero Gasperini and Paolo Vanoli:** in the two previous encounters (the double-header between Atalanta and Torino in the 2024/25 Serie A season), the Viola manager recorded one win and one draw.

**No player has made more defensive recoveries than Evan Ndicka (204)** in the 2025/26 Serie A season.
