



# INSIGHTS - MATCHDAY 30

SERIE A 2025/2026



**CAGLIARI**



**NAPOLI**

**There have been 44 official meetings in Sardinia between the two sides:** Cagliari have won nine (most recently 2-0 in Serie A 2008/09), there have been 22 draws (most recently 1-1 in Serie A 2023/24) and Napoli have won 13 (most recently 4-0 away in Serie A 2024/25).

**Cagliari have not beaten Napoli at home since 19 April 2009:** a 2-0 Serie A win with goals from Jeda and Lazzari. Since then, there have been 14 meetings, ending with five draws and nine Napoli wins.

**In the last 11 meetings in Sardinia, Napoli have scored every time, with 27 goals in total.** The last time Napoli failed to score away to Cagliari was on 23 October 2011, a 0-0 draw in Serie A.

**Cagliari are on a run of six matchdays without a win:** their last victory was on 31 January (Cagliari-Verona 4-0); since then they have recorded two draws and four defeats.

At the Unipol Domus, **the team that have taken the fewest penalties in Serie A (Cagliari, 1) face the side that have conceded the most penalties (Napoli, 8).**

**Cagliari are the most-booked team in Serie A 2025/26 for yellow cards (66).**

**No team averages more defensive recoveries than Cagliari (38.7) in Serie A;** next are Verona (38.0), Napoli (37.8), Roma (37.7) and Juventus (37.4).

**Napoli are coming off three straight wins, all by the same scoreline:** 2-1 away to Verona, then 2-1 vs Torino and 2-1 vs Lecce.

**Napoli have gone 11 consecutive official matches without a clean sheet, conceding 18 goals in total.** Their last clean sheet was on 17 January (Napoli-Sassuolo 1-0, Serie A). Conversely, they have scored in nine straight matches; their last scoreless game was on 25 January (Juventus-Napoli 3-0, Serie A).

**Napoli are among the teams with the most goals in the opening 15 minutes in Serie A 2025/26 (9,** level with Como and Inter).

**Napoli are among the teams with the most different goalscorers in Serie A 2025/26 (18),** level with Juventus.

**Napoli have the highest shot-conversion rate in Serie A 2025/26 (12.4%).** Next are Inter (11.9%), Sassuolo (11.6%), Como (11.5%) and Genoa (11.3%).

**NAPOLI**

**It will be the third official meeting between Fabio Pisacane and Antonio Conte:** in the previous two (both this season, across the league and the Coppa Italia), Conte has recorded one win and one draw.

**Of the five Serie A titles won by Antonio Conte as a head coach, two were clinched against Cagliari:** the first in 2011/12 (Cagliari-Juventus 0-2, played in Trieste), and the second in 2024/25 (Napoli-Cagliari 2-0).

UDINESE

**There have been 33 official meetings at Marassi between the two sides:** Genoa have won 16 (most recently 1-0 in last season's Serie A), there have been 12 draws (most recently 0-0 in Serie A 2021/22) and Udinese have won five (most recently 3-1 away in Serie A 2019/20).

**Udinese have gone 330 minutes without scoring at the Ferraris against Genoa:** their last goal there was scored by De Paul from the penalty spot in the 30th minute of Genoa-Udinese 1-1 in Serie A 2020/21.

**On 11 September 1983, Udinese won 5-0 in Genoa on Matchday 1 of Serie A 1983/84:** it featured Zico's first Serie A goals (a brace), with braces also for Viridis, and the fifth Udinese goal scored by Mauro.

**At Marassi, the team with the fewest goals scored by substitutes** (Udinese, 2, level with Verona) **face one of the teams that have conceded the fewest goals to opposition substitutes** (Genoa, 2, level with Lazio, Juventus and Como).

**This match also features two of the four teams that have conceded the most goals in the opening 15 minutes of the second half** (8 each, level with Sassuolo; Fiorentina lead the ranking with 9).

**Genoa have recorded four wins and one defeat in their last five home matches:** the only loss was a 2-3 defeat to Napoli on 7 February.

**Genoa have taken 17 points in the second half of the season:** they rank 7th in the form table, one point behind Milan and level with Juventus.

**Genoa are the team that have contested the most total duels in Serie A 2025/26 (2,410).** However, they also have the lowest duel success rate in the league (46.18%).

Only Inter (20) **have scored more goals from set pieces than Genoa (14) in Serie A 2025/26** (Genoa are level with Napoli).

Only Fiorentina (22) **have dropped more points from winning positions than Genoa (20) in Serie A 2025/26.**

**Genoa are among the teams awarded the most penalties in Serie A 2025/26 (7),** level with Pisa and Milan.

**It will be the second official meeting between Daniele De Rossi and Kosta Runjaić:** their first meeting was the reverse fixture, which De Rossi's side won 2-1 away in Udine.

Only Federico Dimarco (263) and Emanuele Valeri (208) **have attempted more crosses than Aarón Martín (176) in Serie A 2025/26.**

Only Mateo Pellegrino (454) has contested more duels than Lorenzo Colombo (306) among players in Serie A 2025/26.

Only Federico Dimarco (21), Lautaro Martínez (18), Kenan Yıldız (15) and Nico Paz (15) have more goal contributions than Keinan Davis (12) among players in Serie A 2025/26.



PARMA



CREMONESE

**There have been 28 meetings in Emilia between the two sides:** the hosts have won 16 (most recently 1-0 in Serie B 2017/18), there have been seven draws (most recently 1-1 in Serie B 2023/24) and Cremonese have won five (most recently 2-1 away in Serie B 2021/22).

**In Serie A, the fixture at the Tardini has been absent since 10 April 1996:** a 2-0 home win, with goals from Mussi and Zola. The match had originally been scheduled for 17 March 1996, but was postponed due to a players' strike.

**Across the nine Serie A meetings between the Tardini and the Zini, Cremonese have never beaten Parma:** four draws and five Parma wins. Gianfranco Zola is the top scorer in the top-flight meetings with five goals; no other player has scored more than one.

**In the last eight meetings at the Tardini against Parma, Cremonese have managed only one win:** 2-1 on 19 September 2021 in Serie B. The rest of the record is four defeats and three draws.

**Parma have just seen a run of five straight unbeaten results come to an end:** before the 4-1 defeat in Torino-Parma, they had not lost since 1 February, when they were beaten 4-1 at home by Juventus. In that unbeaten spell, they recorded three wins and two draws.

**Parma are the Serie A 2025/26 team that have benefited from the most opposition red cards (7).**

**Parma are among the lowest-scoring teams in Serie A 2025/26 with 21 goals,** level with Lecce.

**Cremonese have gone 15 matchdays without a win:** their last victory was on 7 December 2025 (Cremonese-Lecce 2-0). Since then, they have recorded four draws and 11 defeats. It is the longest current winless run across Europe's top five leagues (next are Metz in Ligue 1 with 14, Heidenheim in the Bundesliga with 13, Tottenham in the Premier League with 12, and Espanyol and Elche in LaLiga with 11).

**Cremonese conceded four goals in their last match:** it is the third time this season they have conceded four or more in a single game (also Inter-Cremonese 4-1 on 4 October 2025 and Juventus-Cremonese 5-0 on 12 January 2026).

**It will be the first official meeting between Carlos Cuesta and Marco Giampaolo.**

**CREMONESE**

**Marco Giampaolo returns as Cremonese head coach:** he previously managed the Grigiorossi from November 2014 to June 2015 in Serie C, taking charge of 26 official matches with a record of 9 wins, 10 draws and 7 defeats.

**Emanuele Valeri is the ex of the day:** he made 107 appearances and scored seven goals for Cremonese between 2020/21 and 2022/23, the club he has represented most often in his career.

Only Federico Dimarco (263) **has attempted more crosses than Emanuele Valeri (208) in Serie A 2025/26.**

**Mateo Pellegrino scored against Torino:** it was the Argentine striker's eighth league goal of the season. He is also the top scorer in Serie A in the 2026 calendar year with five goals, moving ahead of Lautaro Martínez.

**Only Arijanet Murić (104) has made more saves than Emil Audero (103) in Serie A 2025/26.**

Only Federico Dimarco (99) and Luka Modrić (68) **have taken more corners than Jari Vandeputte (65) in Serie A 2025/26.**

**David Okereke scored against Fiorentina:** it was the Cremonese forward's first league goal of the season. He had not scored in an official match since 20 April 2025 (Başakşehir-Gaziantep 2-1, Trendyol Süper Lig). In Italy, he had not scored since 12 November 2023 (Brescia-Cremonese 0-3, Serie B), while his last Serie A goal dated back to 3 May 2023 (Milan-Cremonese 1-1).



MILAN



TORINO

**There have been 94 official meetings in Milan between the two sides:** Milan have won 54 (most recently 4-1 in Serie A 2023/24), there have been 25 draws (most recently 2-2 in Serie A 2024/25) and Torino have won 15 (most recently 1-0 in the Coppa Italia 2022/23).

**Torino's last Serie A win away to Milan dates back to 24 March 1985:** a 1-0 victory, decided by Schachner in the 61st minute. Since then, the teams have met 29 times at Milan's home venue in the league, with 20 Milan wins and nine draws.

At the Meazza, **two of the three Serie A 2025/26 teams that have not benefited from any opposition red cards face each other (the other team is Verona).**

**Milan have recorded two wins and two defeats in their last four Serie A matches,** scoring three and conceding two.

**Milan are the Serie A 2025/26 team to have made the fewest substitutions:** 113 out of 145 available.

**Milan have the best defence in Serie A 2025/26, with 21 goals conceded.**

**Milan are among the teams with the most goals scored in the final 15 minutes of the first half** (stoppage time included) (10, level with Inter).

Only Verona (51) **have conceded more goals than Torino (50) in Serie A 2025/26.**

Only Cremonese (260) **attempt fewer dribbles than Torino (297) in Serie A 2025/26.**

**It will be the sixth official meeting between Massimiliano Allegri and Roberto D'Aversa:** in the previous five, Allegri has recorded four wins and one draw.

**Roberto D'Aversa is the ex of the day:** as a player, he was part of Milan's youth academy from 1991 to 1994.

Only Manuel Locatelli (403) **has completed more successful passes in the attacking half than Luka Modrić (319) in Serie A 2025/26.**

**Giovanni Simeone scored against Parma:** it was his seventh league goal of the season, and he has scored two goals in his last three Serie A matches.

**Duván Zapata scored against Parma:** it was his third league goal of the season, and he has scored two goals in his last three Serie A matches.



**SASSUOLO**

**There have been 12 meetings in Turin between the two sides:** Juventus have won 10 (most recently 3-0 in Serie A 2023/24), there has been one draw (most recently 2-2 in Serie A 2019/20) and Sassuolo have won one (most recently 2-1 away in Serie A 2021/22).

**Juventus have scored in all 12 home matches against Sassuolo** (32 goals in total).

**Juventus are the Serie A 2025/26 team with the fewest yellow cards (34).**

**Juventus are coming off two consecutive wins without conceding.** They had not kept back-to-back clean sheets in Serie A 2025/26 since the wins over Sassuolo (3-0 away) and Cremonese (5-0) in January 2026.

**Juventus are among the four teams that have conceded the fewest goals to opposition substitutes in Serie A 2025/26 (2),** level with Genoa, Lazio and Como.

**Juventus are the Serie A 2025/26 team with the most dribbles attempted (491).**

Only Napoli (19) **have had more different goalscorers than Juventus (18) in Serie A 2025/26.**

Only Inter (849) **have attempted more crosses than Juventus (701) in Serie A 2025/26.**

Sassuolo have gone 11 matchdays without a draw (five wins and six defeats). **Their last draw was Sassuolo-Parma 1-1 on 3 January 2026.**

**It will be the second official meeting between Luciano Spalletti and Fabio Grosso:** Spalletti's Juventus won the reverse fixture 3-0 at the Mapei Stadium.

**Kenan Yıldız is the player with the most completed dribbles in Serie A 2025/26 (86).**

**Manuel Locatelli is the player who has completed the most forward passes in Serie A 2025/26 (894).**

**Jérémie Boga scored against Udinese:** it was his third straight goal in Serie A 2025/26 – the first time in his career he has scored in three consecutive matches.

**Jay Idzes has made the most defensive recoveries in Serie A 2025/26 (169).**

**Armand Laurienté is the most substituted player in Serie A 2025/26, having been taken off 22 times.**



**There have been 15 meetings in Como between the two sides:** Como have won five (most recently 3-1 in Serie B 2023/24), there have been seven draws (most recently 2-2 in Serie B 2022/23) and Pisa have won three (most recently 1-0 away in Serie B 2021/22).

**The last Serie A meeting between Como and Pisa at the Sinigaglia dates back to 8 January 1989:** a 1-1 draw, with goals from Simone for Como and Boccafresca for Pisa. Rino Marchesi was on the Como bench, with Bruno Bolchi in charge of Pisa.

**Como are among the four Serie A 2025/26 teams that have conceded the fewest goals to opposition substitutes (2),** level with Genoa, Lazio and Juventus.

**Only Inter (23) have won more points than Como (21) in the second half of the season in Serie A 2025/26.**

**Como have recorded seven wins, four draws and just one defeat in their last 12 official matches** (the only loss was 2-1 at home to Fiorentina on 14 February 2026).

**Como are among the top teams for goals scored in the opening 15 minutes in Serie A 2025/26 (9,** level with Napoli and Inter).

**In Serie A, Como have never been this high in the table at this stage of a season.** They have surpassed their previous best (6th place after 29 matchdays in 1950/51). After their win over Roma (their 15th of the season), Como are also closing in on their club record for wins in a single Serie A campaign (18).

**No Serie A team has improved more than Como compared with last season:** they are 25 points better off and nine places higher in the standings.

**Pisa are among the teams awarded the most penalties in Serie A 2025/26 (7),** level with Milan and Genoa.

**Pisa are the worst away side in Serie A 2025/26 for points won (8)** and also the team that have conceded the most goals away (31).

**Pisa have not won an away match in Serie A since 24 March 1991, a 3-2 victory at Parma.** In their next 17 away matches (across that season and the current one), they have recorded nine draws and eight defeats.

**With their win over Cagliari, Pisa ended a run of 17 matches without a win** (their previous win had come against Cremonese on 7 November 2025).



**Across Europe's top five leagues, no team has won fewer matches than Pisa (2).** In addition, only Bournemouth (14) have drawn more matches than the Tuscan side (12).

**It will be the first official meeting between Cesc Fàbregas and Oscar Hiljemark.**

**Anastasios Douvikas scored against Roma:** the Greek forward has now reached 10 Serie A goals this season, with only Lautaro Martínez scoring more (14). The last Como player to hit double figures in a single Serie A campaign was Stefano Borgonovo in 1985/86 (10). Douvikas is also third among Greek scorers in Serie A history with 12 goals, behind Panagiotis Konè (14) and Zisis Vryzas (25).

**Antonio Caracciolo scored against Cagliari:** it was the Pisa defender's first brace as a professional.



**In the 44 official precedents in Bergamo** the record sees 25 Nerazzurri victories (the latest 6-1, Serie A 2024/25), 11 draws (the latest 2-2, Serie A 2023/24) and 8 Scaligeri victories (the latest 0-2, Serie A 2021/22).

**On 12 May 1985 Verona mathematically won their first and only scudetto precisely in Bergamo:** on the penultimate matchday of the championship 1-1 with Nerazzurri lead by Perico and Scaligeri equaliser by Elkjaer Larsen.

**In the last 6 matches in Bergamo Verona has always scored at least 1 goal** (10 in total); last without goals on 25 October 2017 (Atalanta-Verona 3-0, Serie A).

Before the Champions League second leg in Munich, **Atalanta without victories for 5 official matches** (4-1 against Borussia Dortmund on 25 February) **and without clean sheets for 8 official matches** (on 14 February in the 0-2 against Lazio), with 17 goals conceded in total.

**Counting the matches of the second half of the season Atalanta has collected 19 points:** 4th in this partial ranking behind Napoli (20), Como (21) and Inter (23).

**Atalanta team with the widest negative differential between goals and expected goals in Serie A 2025/26 (-14.32, result of 40 goals scored and 54.32 xG produced).**

**Only Napoli (19) and Juventus (18) count more different scorers than Atalanta (17) in Serie A 2025/26.** Atalanta is however the Serie A 2025/26 club with the lowest number of players fielded in the 29 league matchdays (24).

**Only Inter (246) and Pisa (170) have completed more crosses than Atalanta (168) in Serie A 2025/26.**

**Only Lecce and Parma (21) have scored fewer goals than Verona (22) in Serie A 2025/26.**

**No team concedes more goals than Verona (51) in Serie A 2025/26.**

**Only Genoa (2410) has engaged more duels than Verona (2347) among the teams of Serie A 2025/26.**

**No team of Serie A 2025/26 has scored with fewer different players than Verona (10, like Parma and Torino).** Verona is however the Serie A 2025/26 club with the highest number of players fielded in the 29 league matchdays (34).



**Verona team of Serie A 2025/26 that scores fewest goals with substitute players (2, like Udinese) and that concedes most (10).**

**Only Como (1) has fielded fewer Italian players than Verona (3) among the teams of Serie A 2025/26.**

**Between Raffaele Palladino and Paolo Sammarco first official encounter.**

**Charles De Ketelaere is the player of Serie A 2025/26 with the highest number of passes attempted (82) and completed (54) in the penalty area.**

**No player has won more duels than Victor Nelsson (187, like Tiago Gabriel) among the players of Serie A 2025/26.**



**BOLOGNA**



**LAZIO**

**There are 80 official precedents between the two teams in Emilia:** record of 44 Bologna victories (latest 5-0, Serie A 2024/25), 20 draws (latest 1-1, Coppa Italia 2025/26) and 16 Lazio victories (latest 0-2, Serie A 2018/19).

**In the last 7 matches at the Dall'Ara, Lazio never victorious in regular time** (victory on penalties on 11 February 2026 in Coppa Italia, after the 1-1 at 90'). Completing the record 4 Bologna victories and 2 draws, with 2 goals scored and 13 goals conceded for the Biancocelesti.

Starting from the 2015/16 season, among the players currently present in the squads of Bologna and Lazio, **Mattia Zaccagni (3 goals) is the top scorer in the matches between Bologna and Lazio in all competitions.** Following Santiago Castro and Jens Odgaard, at 2 each.

**Bologna coming off 2 victories in the last 12 official home matches** (both 1-0, against Udinese in Serie A and Brann in Europa League), with remaining record of 4 draws and 6 defeats.

**Only Milan and Inter (10) score more goals than Bologna (9)** in the last 15' of the first half in Serie A 2025/26.

**Bologna team of Serie A 2025/26 that scores most goals in the first 15' of the second half (11).**

**Bologna team of Serie A that makes most substitutions (144 out of the 145 available).**

Only Fiorentina (-20) **has a more negative points balance in the standings than Bologna and Lazio (both -11) compared to the 29th matchday of the 2024/25 championship.**

**Lazio coming off 2 victories in a row in Serie A (against Sassuolo and Milan):** it is the first time this happens in this championship. Before these, it had happened in February 2025, with Cagliari-Lazio 1-2 and Lazio-Monza 5-1.

**Lazio team of Serie A 2025/26 that has suffered most expulsions (7).**

**Lazio team of Serie A 2025/26 that concedes fewest goals from substitute players (2, like Como, Genoa and Juventus).**

**Lazio team of Serie A 2025/26 with fewest goals scored away (8).**

**LAZIO**

**Only Inter and Milan (10 each) concede fewer goals than Lazio (11) away in Serie A 2025/26.**

**Between Vincenzo Italiano and Maurizio Sarri 9th official encounter:** 1 victory for the Bologna coach, 3 draws and 4 victories for the Lazio coach.

**Only Jean Butez (644) completes more forward passes in the defensive half than Mario Gila (557) and Alessio Romagnoli (540) in Serie A 2025/26.**

**Gustav Isaksen on target against Milan:** 4th goal in this championship for the Dane. He has equalled his best championship in Italy in terms of goals, 2024/25. Only on 2 occasions in his career has he scored more in a single tournament: 5 goals in 2020/21 and 18 in 2022/23 with Midtjylland in Danish Superliga.

**Thijs Dallinga on target against Sassuolo:** 2nd goal in this championship for the Netherlands striker. He had not scored a goal since 22 January in Bologna-Celtic 2-2 in Europa League; in Serie A instead since 9 November 2025 in Bologna-Napoli 2-0.

**Riccardo Orsolini is the player of Serie A 2025/26 who hits the woodwork most (5).**



ROMA



LECCE

**There have been 20 official meetings at the Olimpico between the two sides:** Roma have won 17 (most recently 4-1 in last season's Serie A), there have been two draws (most recently 2-2 in Serie A 2004/05) and Lecce have won one (most recently 3-2 in Serie A 1985/86).

**At home, Roma have won the last nine matches against Lecce. Lecce's last positive result at the Olimpico was in October 2004 (2-2 in Serie A).** Roma have scored in all 20 meetings at the Olimpico, for a total of 53 goals.

**A historic reference is 20 April 1986:** Lecce's only win away to Roma came on the penultimate matchday, with Lecce already mathematically relegated to Serie B and Roma in a tight Scudetto race with Juventus, whom they had caught at the top the previous week. Lecce won 3-2: Graziani and Pruzzo scored for Roma, while Di Chiara and Barbas (brace) scored for Lecce.

**Roma are among the teams that have conceded the fewest penalties in Serie A 2025/26 (1),** level with Cagliari.

**Roma are the team that have conceded the fewest first-half goals in Serie A 2025/26 (7).**

**Roma have gone three Serie A matches without a win:** their last victory was on 22 February (Roma-Cremonese 3-0).

**No team has scored fewer goals than Lecce in Serie A 2025/26 (21, level with Parma).**

**Lecce are coming off five away defeats in their last six matches.** Their only win in that run was a 2-0 victory at Cagliari on 16 February 2026.

**It will be the 21st official meeting between Gian Piero Gasperini and Eusebio Di Francesco:** Gasperini leads the head-to-head 11-4, with five draws completing the record.

**Eusebio Di Francesco is the ex of the day:** he coached Roma from July 2017 to March 2019, taking charge of 87 official matches with a record of 46 wins, 18 draws and 23 defeats. As a player, he also wore the Roma shirt from 1997/98 to 2000/01 (129 appearances, 16 goals), winning the Scudetto in 2000/01.

Only Mateo Pellegrino (68) **has committed more fouls than Gianluca Mancini (57) in Serie A 2025/26.**

**Wladimiro Falcone is the goalkeeper with the most saves from shots inside the box in Serie A 2025/26 (70).**

LECCE

**Ylber Ramadani leads Serie A 2025/26 for high (attacking) ball recoveries (78).**

Only Manuel Locatelli (62) and Morten Frendrup (61) **have won more tackles than Santiago Pierotti (59) and Danilo Veiga (55) in Serie A 2025/26.**

**Donyell Malen scored against Como:** it was the Dutch forward's seventh Serie A goal of the 2025/26 season, and he is the league's top scorer in the 2026 calendar year. He had not scored since Roma-Juventus 3-3 on 1 March 2026.

**Malen has converted both penalties he has taken across Europe's top five leagues** – both for Roma in Serie A, against Como and Napoli.

**Jamil Siebert scored against Napoli:** it was the Lecce defender's first Serie A goal. He had not scored in an official match since 27 October 2023, in Braunschweig-Fortuna 1-4 (2. Bundesliga).

**Konan N'Dri is one of three players with the most substitute appearances in Serie A 2025/26 (19),** level with Riyad Idrissi (Cagliari) and Amin Sarr (Verona).

**There are 94 official precedents between the two teams in Florence:** record of 33 Viola victories (latest 3-0, Serie A 2024/25), 37 draws (latest 1-1, Serie A 2019/20) and 24 Nerazzurri victories (latest 0-1, Serie A 2023/24).

**Fiorentina coming off 1 victory in the last 10 home matches against Inter:** record of 4 draws (of which one with defeat in extra time, Coppa Italia 2020/21) and 5 defeats.

**Fiorentina team of Serie A 2025/26 that concedes most goals in the first 15' of the second half (9).**

**Only Genoa (17) has conceded more goals from set pieces than Fiorentina (16) in Serie A 2025/26.**

**Inter team of Serie A 2025/26 that scores most goals from set pieces (20).**

**Inter team of Serie A 2025/26 that completes most crosses (246).**

**Inter team of Serie A 2025/26 that scores most goals with substitute players (11).**

**Inter team of Serie A 2025/26 that scores most goals in the first half (28).**

**Inter only team of Serie A 2025/26 without expulsions suffered.**

**Inter team of Serie A 2025/26 with most goals scored in the first 15' of the first half (9, like Napoli and Como), in the last 15' of the first half including stoppage time (10, like Milan) and in the last 15' of the match including stoppage time (17).**

**Inter coming off 2 consecutive matches without victories in Serie A:** it is the second time this happens in this championship, after Inter-Udinese 1-2 and Juventus-Inter 4-3 between August and September 2025.

**Inter coming off 2 official away matches without goals (Como-Inter 0-0, Coppa Italia and Milan-Inter 0-1, Serie A).** It was since February 2025 that the Nerazzurri had not scored for two consecutive away matches (Fiorentina-Inter 3-0 and Juventus-Inter 1-0).

**Federico Dimarco is the player in Serie A 2025/26 who has attempted most crosses (263) and made most key passes (68).**
