



INSIGHTS - MATCHDAY 23

SERIE A ENILIVE 2025/2026



There have been 67 meetings in Rome between the two sides: Lazio have won 37 (most recently 3-0 in Serie A 2024/25), there have been 21 draws (most recently 1-1 in Serie A 2008/09) and Genoa have won nine (most recently 1-0 away in Serie A 2023/24).

Genoa have gone 254 minutes without scoring at the Olimpico against Lazio: their last goal there was scored by Retegui (16th minute of Lazio–Genoa 0–1, Serie A, 27 August 2023).

There has been no draw at the Olimpico for 17 matches in this fixture (the last was Lazio–Genoa 1–1, Serie A, 23 November 2008): since then, Lazio have won 11 and Genoa six.

Lazio have recorded only one win in their last seven matchdays: the sole success was Verona–Lazio 1-0 on 11 January; otherwise they have posted four draws and two defeats.

Lazio have not scored in the league for 191 minutes (the most recent “goal” was an own goal by Nelsson, 79th minute of Verona–Lazio). The last goal scored by a Lazio player dates back to 7 January, when Pedro scored in stoppage time of Lazio–Fiorentina 2–2.

Lazio are the Serie A 2025/26 team with the most red cards received (7).

Lazio have not had fewer than 30 points after 22 matchdays since 2009/10 (they had 22 that season, coached by Ballardini).

Genoa are the team that have conceded the most goals in the opening 15 minutes of the second half in Serie A 2025/26 (6), level with Udinese and Fiorentina.

Genoa are unbeaten in five matches (two wins and three draws); their last defeat came on 29 December 2025, also at the Olimpico (Roma–Genoa 3–1).

It will be the first official meeting between Maurizio Sarri and Daniele De Rossi.

As a player, De Rossi faced Lazio 31 times: 14 wins, seven draws and 10 defeats, scoring two goals.

Alessandro Marcandalli and Johan Vásquez have started every match under De Rossi: 13 appearances each in all competitions. **Vásquez is also the player with the most minutes under the Rome-born coach (1,153).**



There are 3 official precedents between the two teams in Tuscany: record of 2 Pisa victories (the latest 3-1 in Serie B 2024/25) and 1 draw (the latest 0-0 in Serie B 2008/09). This is the first match in Serie A between the two teams.

Pisa team of Serie A 2025/26 that has taken most penalties (6).

Only Torino (20) has conceded more goals than Pisa (16) in first halves in Serie A 2025/26.

Pisa team of Serie A 2025/26 that concedes most goals in second halves (21, like Lecce and Fiorentina).

Pisa team of Serie A 2025/26 with fewest goals scored at home (2).

Pisa team of Serie A 2025/26 with fewest home victories (1, against Cremonese on 7 November 2025 with the result of 1-0).

Only one victory in 22 matchdays for Pisa: the last victory against Cremonese 1-0 on 7 November 2025. In the subsequent matchdays the Nerazzurri have collected 5 draws and 6 defeats without ever managing to keep a clean sheet, for a total of 23 goals conceded.

Sassuolo without away victories for 5 matches: the last away victory dates back to 0-3 in Bergamo against Atalanta on 9 November 2025. In the subsequent away matches the Neroverdi have collected 3 defeats and 2 draws.

The top scorer in the 7 official matches between Pisa and Sassuolo is Matteo Tramoni, with 2 goals.

Between Alberto Gilardino and Fabio Grosso 4th official encounter: in the 3 precedents, one victory each and one draw.

Idrissa Tourè (103) is the player who has won most aerial duels in Serie A 2025/26. In fourth place of this special ranking Canestrelli, with 86.

Stefano Moreo on target against Inter: it is his second brace in this championship, the first came on 2 November 2025 (Torino-Pisa 2-2).

Alieu Fadera on target against Cremonese: second goal in this championship for the Gambian. He had not scored a goal in Serie A since 14 September 2025 (Sassuolo-Lazio 1-0).



NAPOLI



FIorentINA

There are 87 official precedents between the two teams in Naples: record of 40 Neapolitan victories (the latest 2-1 in Serie A 2024/25), 26 draws (the latest 0-0 in Serie A 2017/18) and 21 Fiorentina victories (the latest 1-3 in Serie A 2023/24).

Among the illustrious precedents, the one from 10 May 1987 is remembered: Napoli-Fiorentina 1-1, penultimate matchday of the championship, scorers Carnevale for the hosts and Baggio for the Viola. With the point gained, Napoli became Champion of Italy for the first time.

Another match to remember that of 31 December 1955: Napoli-Fiorentina 2-4, played on neutral ground in Rome, was one of the first live TV broadcasts on RAI. In that season, Fiorentina won its first Scudetto.

Facing at the Maradona the team that loses most points from leading situations in Serie A (Fiorentina, 20) and the one that loses the fewest (Napoli, 0 - like Roma).

Napoli without home defeats in all competitions since 8 December 2024 (Napoli-Lazio 0-1): since then, 15 victories and 6 draws.

Napoli defeated in Turin with 3 goals margin: only on 4 other occasions had Antonio Conte suffered in his career a defeat in Serie A with a deficit of 3 goals (2 on the Atalanta bench in 2009/10 and 2 last season with Napoli).

Before Juventus-Napoli, the Azzurri had not conceded at least 3 goals in the same match since 21 October 2025 (PSV-Napoli 6-2, Champions League) and in Serie A since 3 November 2024 (Napoli-Atalanta 0-3).

Napoli at 43 points after 22 matchdays: it is 10 less than the 2024/25 season and 16 less than the 2022/23 season, the two ended with the Scudetto victory.

Napoli team of Serie A 2025/26 that scores fewest goals with substitute players (1), like Parma and Udinese: the only goal from the bench signed by Lucca (82' of Napoli-Pisa 3-2, 4th matchday).

Fiorentina team of Serie A 2025/26 that concedes most goals in the first 15' of the second half (6), like Udinese and Genoa.

Between Antonio Conte and Paolo Vanoli 3rd official encounter: in the two precedents, double victory of the Napoli coach in Serie A 2024/25.



NAPOLI



FIorentINA

Before Juventus-Napoli, **Alex Meret had not played a Serie A match since 28 September 2025** (Milan-Napoli 2-1).

Marco Brescianini scored against Cagliari: he had not scored in an official match since 25 October 2025 (Cremonese-Atalanta 1-1).



In the 36 meetings in Sardinia between the two sides, Cagliari have won 19 (most recently 2-1 in last season's Serie A), there have been nine draws (most recently 1-1 in Serie A 2023/24) and Verona have won eight (most recently 2-1 away in Serie A 2021/22).

After 22 matchdays, **Pisacane's Cagliari have four points more than last season's side coached** by Davide Nicola, and seven points more than Claudio Ranieri's team in 2023/24.

Cagliari are the second-highest team in Serie A 2025/26 for different goalscorers (15); only Juventus (16) have more.

Cagliari are among the teams with the fewest penalties won in Serie A 2025/26 (1), level with Lecce.

Cagliari and Verona have not received a red card in Serie A 2025/26, like Inter and Torino.

Cagliari (53) and Verona (50) are the teams with the most yellow cards in Serie A 2025/26.

Verona are among the teams with the fewest different goalscorers in Serie A 2025/26 (7), level with Parma.

Verona are the team that have dropped the most points in second halves compared with the half-time score (-11) in Serie A 2025/26.

Since returning to Serie A on a permanent basis in summer 2019, this is Verona's worst start after 22 matchdays, with 14 points. They had 17 at this stage in 2022/23, and 18 in 2023/24.

Verona have not won a Serie A match since 14 December 2025 (Fiorentina-Verona 1-2): in the seven matches since, they have recorded two draws and five defeats.

It will be the second official meeting between Fabio Pisacane and Paolo Zanetti: the reverse fixture at the Bentegodi ended 2-2.

Marco Palestra scored against Fiorentina: it was the Cagliari wide player's first-ever Serie A goal.

Amin Sarr is the player who has come off the bench the most times in Serie A 2025/26 (16), level with Walid Cheddira.



TORINO



LECCE

There are 16 official precedents between the two teams in Turin: record of 10 Granata victories (latest 2-0 in Serie A 2023/24), 4 draws and 2 Salentini victories (latest 2-1 in Serie A 2019/20).

Lecce without goals away at Torino for 338': the last goal is by Stępiński at 22' of Torino-Lecce in Coppa Italia on 28 October 2020.

Before Como-Torino, the Granata had not conceded at least 6 goals in the same match since 12 May 2021 (Torino-Milan 0-7).

Torino one of the teams that has not yet received red cards in Serie A 2025/26, like Inter, Verona and Cagliari.

Torino coming off 4 consecutive defeats in Serie A: 12 goals conceded in the period by the Granata.

Torino without goals in Serie A for 273': last goal by Casadei at minute 87 of Torino-Udinese 1-2 on 7 January.

Torino team with most goals conceded in Serie A 2025/26 (40).

Torino at 23 points in the standings after 22 matchdays: to find a worse performance, one must go back to the 2020/21 season (17 points after 22 matches).

Torino and Lecce teams of Serie A 25/26 that concede most goals from opponent substitutes (7).

Lecce without victories since 12 December (1-0 against Pisa), since that moment 2 draws and 5 defeats.

Lecce team with fewest goals scored in Serie A 2025/26 (13).

Lecce without goals for 359', last goal scored by Stulic at 1' of Lecce-Parma 1-2, 11 January.

Between Marco Baroni and Eusebio Di Francesco 9th official encounter: in the 8 precedents, 1 victory for the first, 5 victories for the second and 2 draws.

Marco Baroni ex of the matchday: he coached Lecce in the 2021/22 and 2022/23 seasons, obtaining a promotion and survival in Serie A.



TORINO

Only Idrissa Tourè (103) has won more aerial duels than Tiago Gabriel (90) in Serie A 2025/26.



ATALANTA

There have been 28 Lombardy derbies in Como: Como have won 15 (most recently 1-0 in Serie A 1988/89), there have been seven draws (most recently 1-1 in Serie A 2002/03) and Atalanta have won six (most recently 2-1 away in Serie A 2024/25).

Como's last home win over Atalanta at the Sinigaglia dates back to 14 May 1989: a 1-0 Serie A victory, decided by Marco Simone.

It is since 1952/53 that Como last won at least 10 matches in a single Serie A season: they won 11 that year – the same number as they have now. Como's all-time club record is 18 wins in 1950/51.

Como have won six of their last eight official matches; the only two games they failed to win were a 1-1 home draw with Bologna and a 1-3 home defeat to Milan.

Only Inter (50) have scored more goals than Como (37) in Serie A 2025/26.

Only Roma (13) have conceded fewer goals than Como (16) in Serie A 2025/26.

Only Inter (7) have scored more goals through substitutes than Como and Atalanta (6 each – level with Juventus and Milan) in Serie A 2025/26.

Atalanta have taken 13 points from their last five league matches, with four wins and one draw. Their last defeat came on 28 December 2025, when Inter won 1-0 in Bergamo.

Atalanta have 35 points after 22 matchdays: the Bergamaschi have not had a record like this at this stage of the season since 2018/19. That year, they still finished third with 69 points.

It will be the third official meeting between Cesc Fàbregas and Raffaele Palladino: their previous two meetings came in last season's two matches between Como and Fiorentina, with one away win each, both ending 2-0.

Since Raffaele Palladino took charge of Atalanta, the Orobici rank fourth in the form table: 22 points from 11 matches. Only Inter (28), Milan (25) and Juventus (23) have done better; Como are also on 22.

Álvaro Morata scored against Fiorentina in the Coppa Italia: the Como striker had not scored in an official match since 24 May 2025 (Göztepe-Galatasaray 0-2). In Serie A, his last goal dated back to 11 January 2025 (Milan-Cagliari 1-1).



ATALANTA

Nicolas Kuhn on target against Torino: first goal in Italy for the German. He had not scored a goal in official matches since 10 May 2025 (Celtic-Hibernian 3-1).

Sergi Roberto on target against Fiorentina in Coppa Italia: first goal in Italy for the Spanish midfielder. He had not scored a goal in official matches since 20 December 2023 (Barcelona-Almeria 3-2).

Giacomo Raspadori on target against Parma: the Orobico striker had not scored a goal in Serie A since 11 May 2025 (Napoli-Genoa 2-2).



10 official precedents between Cremonese and Inter in Cremona: 8 Nerazzurri victories (the latest 1-2 in Serie A 2022/23) and 2 draws (the latest in the Coppa Italia of 1986/87, 1-1 with goals by Lombardo and Mandorlini).

The last victory of Cremonese against the Nerazzurri dates back to 10 May 1992, 0-2 at San Siro in Serie A, since that moment 8 victories for Inter and one draw.

The last victory for the Grigiorossi dates back to 7 December: 2-0 at home against Lecce. In the subsequent 8 matchdays, 3 draws and 5 defeats, with as many as 7 matches without goals.

Cremonese is the team that concedes most goals in the first 15' of the match (6). Inter, with 8 goals, the most prolific.

Cremonese without goals for 331' in Serie A: the last goal scored by Vardy at 29' of Cremonese-Cagliari 2-2 on 8 January.

No expulsions for Inter in the league, like Verona, Torino and Cagliari.

In the top 5 European leagues, no team has achieved more clean sheets than Inter away (6, like Lazio).

Inter coming off nine victories and one draw in the last 10 matchdays: in the period no one has achieved more points than the Nerazzurri (28), six more than Juventus, Milan and Atalanta (22). The last defeat dates back to 23 November, 0-1 against Milan.

Between Davide Nicola and Cristian Chivu second official encounter, after the Nerazzurri victory 4-1 in the first leg match.

Henrikh Mkhitaryan on target against Pisa: first goal in this championship for the Armenian midfielder. He had not scored a goal with the Inter jersey since 27 October 2024 (Inter-Juventus 4-4).

Ange-Yoan Bonny on target against Pisa: the French striker had not scored in official matches since 3 December 2025 (Inter-Venezia 5-1, in Coppa Italia); he had not scored a goal in Serie A since 9 November 2025 (Inter-Lazio 2-0).



Federico Dimarco with the goal and assists achieved against Pisa, has surpassed his own record of goal participations in a single Serie A season (12). The Nerazzurri full-back had not scored and provided an assist in the same match since Inter-Cremonese 4-1 on 4 October 2025.



There have been 34 official meetings in Emilia between Parma and Juventus: Parma have won 11 (most recently 1-0 in last season's Serie A), there have been 11 draws (most recently 1-1 in Serie A 2012/13) and Juventus have won 12 (most recently 4-0 in Serie A 2020/21).

Parma had not conceded four or more goals in a single match since 22 December 2024 (Roma-Parma 5-0).

Parma have gone 311 minutes without scoring in Serie A: their last goal came in the 72nd minute of Lecce-Parma 1-2 on 11 January, scored by Mateo Pellegrino.

Parma have recorded only one win in their last six matchdays (Lecce-Parma, 11 January).

Only Inter (7) have scored more goals through substitutes than Juventus in Serie A 2025/26 (6, level with Como, Atalanta, Milan).

Parma are among the teams with the fewest goals scored by substitutes in Serie A 2025/26 (1), level with Napoli and Udinese. Their only such goal was scored by Cutrone in the 85th minute of Parma-Atalanta 1-1 on 30 August.

Juventus are the Serie A 2025/26 team with the most different goalscorers (16).

Parma are among the teams with the fewest different goalscorers in Serie A 2025/26 (7), level with Verona.

Juventus are the team with the fewest yellow cards in Serie A 2025/26 (27).

Juventus have five more points than they did at the same stage last season: after 22 matchdays, they had 37 points and were sixth.

It will be the first official meeting between Carlos Cuesta and Luciano Spalletti.

Pierre Kalulu (1,170 minutes) is Spalletti's most-used player in Serie A 2025/26, followed by Weston McKennie (1,133) and Manuel Locatelli (1,077).

Filip Kostić scored against Napoli: he had not scored in an official match since 22 November 2025 (Fiorentina-Juventus 1-1). The Serbian has now matched his best Serie A scoring season (3 goals, as in 2022/23).



UDINESE



ROMA

There have been 54 official meetings in Friuli between the two sides: Udinese have won 17 (most recently 4-0 in Serie A 2022/23), there have been 13 draws (most recently 1-1 in Serie A 2021/22) and Roma have won 24 (most recently 2-1 away in Serie A 2024/25).

Udinese have 29 points after 22 matchdays, three more than at the same stage in 2024/25 (26 after 22 games).

Udinese are among the teams with the fewest goals scored by substitutes in Serie A 2025/26 (1), level with Parma and Napoli.

Udinese have not won at home since 14 December (1-0 against Napoli): in the five matches since, they have recorded two draws and three defeats.

Udinese are the team that have conceded the most goals between the 46th and the 60th minute in Serie A 2025/26 (6), level with Genoa and Fiorentina.

Roma are the only Serie A 2025/26 team yet to concede a penalty.

Roma have the best defence in Serie A 2025/26 with 13 goals conceded; however, among teams with 30+ points before Matchday 23, only Bologna have suffered more defeats than the Giallorossi (Roma 7, Bologna 8).

Roma have not had 43 points after 22 matchdays since 2020/21.

It will be the fourth official meeting between Kosta Runjaić and Gian Piero Gasperini: Runjaić has no wins in the three previous meetings, with two wins for Gasperini and one draw.

Matías Soulé is the most frequently substituted player in Serie A 2025/26 (18 times).

After 22 matchdays, **only Lautaro Martínez (16), Nico Paz (14), Federico Dimarco (14) and Kenan Yıldız (12) have more goal contributions than Matías Soulé in Serie A 2025/26.**

Alessandro Zanoli scored against Verona: he had not scored since 4 April 2025 (Genoa-Udinese 1-0). Two of his four Serie A goals have come against Verona.

Paulo Dybala has scored 14 goals against Udinese: it is the opponent he has scored against most often in his career.



BOLOGNA



MILAN

There have been 85 official meetings in Bologna between the two sides: Bologna have won 29 (most recently 2-1 in Serie A 2024/25), there have been 24 draws (most recently 1-1 in Serie A 2022/23) and Milan have won 32 (most recently 2-0 in Serie A 2023/24).

After 22 matchdays in Serie A 2024/25, Bologna had collected 37 points (seven more than they have now), while Milan had 34 points (13 fewer than they have this season).

Bologna are among the teams with the most goals scored in the final 15 minutes of the first half (stoppage time included) in Serie A 2025/26 (8, level with Inter). They also lead the league for goals scored in the opening 15 minutes of the second half (9, level with Milan).

Bologna have recorded only one win in their last 10 matchdays: their last victory was a 3-2 win away to Verona on 15 January. In the other nine matches, they have posted three draws and six defeats.

Bologna are the Serie A 2025/26 team to have made the most substitutions (109 out of 110).

Milan are the Serie A 2025/26 team to have made the fewest substitutions (81).

Milan are the team that have conceded the most penalties in Serie A 2025/26 (7).

Milan are the team that have gained the most points in second halves compared with the half-time score (+13) in Serie A 2025/26.

In 2025/26, across Europe's top five leagues, **Milan have the longest unbeaten run (21 matches).**

It will be the 10th official meeting between Vincenzo Italiano and Massimiliano Allegri: Allegri has recorded seven wins, with one draw and one win for Italiano. Six of Allegri's seven wins came by a 1-0 scoreline.

Lewis Ferguson scored against Genoa: it was the Scottish midfielder's first goal of the season. He had not scored for Bologna since 12 January 2025 (Bologna-Roma 2-2).

Koni De Winter scored against Roma: he had not scored in Serie A since 2 February 2025 (Fiorentina-Genoa 2-1).
