



INSIGHTS - MATCHDAY 27

SERIE A 2025/2026



In the 40 precedents between the two teams in Emilia record of 20 Ducali victories (latest 2-1, Serie B 2022/23), 13 draws (latest 0-0, playoff Serie B 2022/23) and 7 Sardinian victories (latest 2-3, Serie A 2024/25).

Cagliari coming off 4 victories in a row against Parma in Serie A: 11 goals scored and 6 conceded.

Cagliari unbeaten for 8 matches in a row in Serie A against Parma: record of 6 victories and 2 draws. Last defeat the 2-0 at the Tardini on 22 September 2018 in Serie A.

Leonardo Pavoletti is the top scorer in the matches between Parma and Cagliari in all competitions: 4 goals, like Marco Osio.

Only Verona (8) sends fewer players to score than Parma (9, like Torino) in Serie A 2025/26.

Facing the two teams of Serie A 2025/26 that take fewest penalties: 2 for the Emilians (like Cremonese), 1 for the Sardinians (like Lecce).

Cagliari without goals for 270': last goal by Idrissi at 91' of Cagliari-Verona 4-0 last 31 January.

Cagliari team of Serie A 2025/26 that receives most yellow cards (59, like Como).

Between Carlos Cuesta and Fabio Pisacane 2nd official encounter: in the only precedent, the first leg match, 2-0 for the Cagliari coach.

Crossing paths the first and third youngest coach of Serie A 2025/26: born in 1995 Cuesta, born in 1986 Pisacane. In second place Oscar Hiljemark (Pisa), born in 1992.

Mariano Troilo on target against Milan: first goal in Serie A for the defender. He has become the 12th Argentine player to score for Parma in the top division (leading Hernan Crespo with 72 goals). He had not scored a goal in official competitions since 12 February 2025 in Belgrano-Aldosivi 2-0, Liga Profesional de Futbol.

Yerry Mina sent off against Lazio: first red card in this championship for a Cagliari player. It is the second expulsion in Serie A for the Colombian, after that of 4 November 2024 (Lazio-Cagliari 2-1).



COMO



LECCE

The precedents in Como between the two teams are 15: 11 Lariani victories (latest 2-0, Serie A 2024/25), 3 draws (latest 1-1, Serie B 2021/22) and 1 Salentini victory (0-1, Coppa Italia 1982/83).

Facing at the Sinigaglia the second team of Serie A 2025/26 to have conceded fewest goals (Como, 19) and the team that scores fewest goals (Lecce, 17).

Como scoring for 9 matches in a row in home matches against Lecce, for a total of 17 goals. Last match without goals scored 22 August 1982, 0-1 in Coppa Italia.

Como coming off one victory in the last 5 home rounds (Como-Torino 6-0, 24 January): remaining record of 2 draws and 2 defeats.

Lecce team of Serie A that concedes most goals (12) from 61' to 75'.

Lecce one of the 4 teams of Serie A that has not yet benefited from opponent expulsions (together with Milan, Verona and Torino).

Lecce team of Serie A 2025/26 that concedes most goals (9) from substitute players.

Between Cesc Fabregas and Eusebio Di Francesco 4th official encounter: the Spanish coach unbeaten in the 3 precedents thanks to 1 victory and 2 draws.

Mergim Vojvoda on target against Juventus: 2nd goal in the league, equalled his own seasonal record (2 in the 2020/21 season at Torino).

Maxime Caqueret on target against Juventus: 2nd goal in the league, equalled his own seasonal record (2 in the 2024/25 season, also at Como).

No player has scored more goals from outside the box than Nico Paz (4, like Hakan Calhanoglu and Piotr Zielinski) in Serie A 2025/26.

Konan N'Dri player who came on as substitute most times (18) in Serie A 2025/26.

Only Filippo Terracciano (149) has made more interceptions than Ylber Ramadani (144) in Serie A 2025/26.



There have been 44 official meetings in Verona between the two sides: Verona have won 14 (most recently 3-0 in Serie A 2024/25), there have been 11 draws (most recently 1-1 in Serie B 2003/04) and Napoli have won 19 (most recently 3-1 away in Serie A 2023/24).

There has been no draw in Verona between the teams since the 1-1 Serie B match on 23 September 2003 (goals by Myrtaj from the spot and Tosto). Since then, across 11 meetings, Verona have won three and Napoli eight.

Verona have recorded just one win in their last 10 matches against Napoli: the remaining record is five Napoli wins and four draws.

Verona are among the teams with the fewest different goalscorers in Serie A 2025/26 (8).

Verona have gone 11 matchdays without a win (three draws and eight defeats). Their last victory was a 2-1 away win at Fiorentina on 14 December 2025. Their last home win was a 3-1 victory over Atalanta on 6 December 2025.

Verona are the team that have dropped the most points in second halves compared with the half-time score (-12) in Serie A 2025/26.

Verona are one of four Serie A teams yet to benefit from any opposition red cards, along with Milan, Lecce and Torino.

Verona are the team that have conceded the most goals in the final 15 minutes (stoppage time included) in Serie A 2025/26 (15).

Napoli are coming off three straight Serie A matches in which they conceded at least two goals – something that had not happened since March-April 2024 (Napoli-Atalanta 0-3, Monza-Napoli 2-4, Napoli-Frosinone 2-2). It had not happened to a team coached by Antonio Conte in Serie A since January 2021, when he was in charge of Inter (Inter-Crotone 6-2, Sampdoria-Inter 2-1, Roma-Inter 2-2).

Napoli are the team that have conceded the most penalties in Serie A 2025/26 (8).

It will be the first official meeting between Paolo Sammarco and Antonio Conte.

Ali Al-Musrati was sent off against Sassuolo: it was the third red card received by a Verona player in the league this season. His previous career dismissal dates back to 12 February 2025, in Monaco-Benfica 1-2 in the Champions League, when he was playing for the French side.



Sam Beukema scored against Atalanta: it was the Dutch defender's second league goal of the season. He had not scored since 13 September 2025, in Fiorentina-Napoli 0-3.



There have been 63 official meetings in Milan between the two sides: Inter have won 49 (most recently 1-0 in last season's Serie A), there have been 10 draws (most recently 1-1 in Serie A 2012/13) and Genoa have won four (most recently 3-1 away in Serie A 1993/94).

Since Genoa's last official win away to Inter (Inter-Genoa 1-3 on 26 March 1994, with a Ruotolo brace and a goal from Skuhravý after Schillaci had put Inter ahead), the record has been 18 Inter wins (including 11 straight in the last 11 meetings) and three draws.

Inter have scored in 14 consecutive home matches against Genoa, for a total of 39 goals. The last time Inter failed to score at home in this fixture was on 7 March 2010 (Inter-Genoa 0-0).

In Serie A history, only one team have failed to win the Scudetto despite collecting 64+ points after 26 matchdays: Maurizio Sarri's Napoli in 2017/18. That season remains Napoli's highest-ever points total in Serie A (91) and is also the points record for a runner-up.

Inter are the Serie A 2025/26 team with the fewest red cards received (0).

Inter are the top team in Serie A 2025/26 for goals scored by substitutes (10).

Inter have won the most points in the second half of the season in Serie A 2025/26 (19 out of 21 possible). Their only draw in that run was a 2-2 home draw against Napoli on 11 January.

Inter have been unbeaten in Serie A since 23 November 2025, when they lost 0-1 at home to Milan. Since then, they have put together a 14-match unbeaten run – the longest among teams in Europe's top five leagues, second only to Borussia Dortmund (15).

Inter are the team with the most goals scored in the opening 15 minutes in Serie A 2025/26 (9).

Inter are also top for goals scored in the final 15 minutes of the first half (stoppage time included)(9, level with Milan).

Inter are the team with the most goals scored in the final 15 minutes of matches (stoppage time included) in Serie A 2025/26 (17).

Genoa are the team that have conceded the fewest goals to opposition substitutes in Serie A 2025/26 (1).



It will be the second official meeting between Cristian Chivu and Daniele De Rossi: Inter won the reverse fixture 2-1.

Cristian Chivu and Daniele De Rossi had been teammates at Roma in the period from 2003/04 to 2006/07: the two won the Coppa Italia of 2006/07.

Lautaro Martínez (5 goals in the calendar year 2026 in Serie A) is one of the 3 top scorers of the tournament since the beginning of January, like Donyell Malen (Roma) and Nikola Krstovic (Atalanta).

Henrikh Mkhitaryan on target against Lecce: 2nd goal in this championship for the Nerazzurri midfielder. He had not scored a goal in official matches since 23 January 2026, Inter-Pisa 6-2, in Serie A. The Armenian scored his only hat-trick since being in Italy precisely against Genoa, with the Roma jersey, on 8 November 2020.

Brooke Norton-Cuffy on target against Torino: 2nd goal in this championship for the English full-back. The other goal had come against Udinese in Udine on 8 December 2025.



CREMONESE



MILAN

The official precedents in Cremona between the two teams are 10: 2 Grigiorossi victories (latest 1-0, Serie A 1994/95), 4 draws (latest 0-0, Serie A 2022/23) and 4 Rossoneri victories (latest 0-2, Serie A 1993/94).

Milan without goals at the Zini in the last 3 outings: the last Rossoneri goal in Cremona signed by Marco Simone at 20' of Cremonese-Milan 0-2, September 1993 in Serie A, since then a drought of 340'.

Cremonese team of Serie A that concedes most goals in the first 15' of play (7, like Sassuolo).

Cremonese without victories since last 7 December (Cremonese-Lecce 2-0): since then for the Grigiorossi 4 draws and 8 defeats in the subsequent 12 matchdays.

Milan team of Serie A that scores most goals in the last 15' of the first half including stoppage time (9, like Inter) and from 46' to 60' (10, like Bologna).

Milan team of Serie A that makes fewest substitutions (100 of the 130 available).

Milan team of Serie A 2025/26 with most penalties in favour (7).

Milan one of the 4 teams of Serie A that has not yet benefited from opponent expulsions (together with Lecce, Verona and Torino).

Milan still unbeaten away: the last away defeat for the Rossoneri in Serie A dates back to last 18 May (Roma-Milan 3-1, 2024/25 season).

Between Davide Nicola and Massimiliano Allegri 11th official encounter: in the 10 precedents, Rossoneri coach ahead 6-1, with 3 draws to close the record. Allegri's teams always scoring, for a total of 23 total goals.



SASSUOLO



ATALANTA

There have been 12 official meetings in Emilia between the two sides: Sassuolo have won three (most recently 1-0 in Serie A 2022/23), there have been three draws (most recently 1-1 in Serie A 2020/21) and Atalanta have won six (most recently 2-0 away in Serie A 2023/24).

Sassuolo are among the teams that have conceded the most goals in the opening 15 minutes of the first half in Serie A 2025/26 (7, level with Cremonese).

Sassuolo are also among the teams that have conceded the most goals in the opening 15 minutes of the second half in Serie A 2025/26 (8, level with Udinese and Fiorentina).

Domenico Berardi is the top scorer in Sassuolo-Atalanta meetings across all competitions, with eight goals. Among players in the current squads, only Charles De Ketelaere comes closest, with three.

Nikola Krstović is among the players with the most Serie A goals in 2026 (5, level with Lautaro Martínez and Donyell Malen).

Atalanta are unbeaten in their last nine Serie A matches (seven wins, two draws); their last defeat dates back to 28 December 2025 (Atalanta-Inter 0-1).

It will be the first official meeting between Fabio Grosso and Raffaele Palladino.

Armand Laurienté is the most substituted player in Serie A 2025/26, having been taken off 21 times.

Domenico Berardi scored against Verona: it was his seventh league goal of the season. It was also his second brace of the campaign, after the one on 9 November 2025 in Atalanta-Sassuolo 1-3. With those two goals, he drew level with Lautaro Martínez in 45th place on the all-time Serie A scoring chart with 129 goals, one behind Graziani and Pascutti.

Andrea Pinamonti scored against Verona: it was the Sassuolo striker's sixth league goal of the season. He had not scored in back-to-back Serie A matches (against Verona and Udinese in the previous round) since February 2025, in Torino-Genoa 1-1 and Genoa-Venezia 2-0.

Lazar Samardžić scored against Napoli: it was the Serbian midfielder's second league goal of the season. He had not scored in Serie A since 4 October 2025 (Atalanta-Como 1-1); overall, he had not scored in an official match since 5 November 2025, in Marseille-Atalanta 0-1 in the Champions League.



SASSUOLO



ATALANTA

Mario Pašalić scored against Napoli: it was the Croatian midfielder's third league goal of the season. He had not scored in Serie A since 10 January, in Atalanta-Torino 2-0.



The official precedents between the two teams in Turin are 72: record of 30 Granata victories (latest 3-1, Serie A 2018/19), 24 draws (latest 0-0, Serie A 2022/23) and 18 Lazio victories (latest 2-3, Serie A 2025/26).

Torino with 4 points gained in the second half of the season: only Pisa (3), Cremonese and Verona (2) have collected fewer.

Torino team that concedes most goals (47) in Serie A 2025/26.

Only Verona (8) sends fewer players to score than Torino (9, like Parma) in Serie A 2025/26.

Lazio without goals in Serie A for 223': last goal signed by Isaksen at 47' of Juventus-Lazio 2-2 last 8 February.

Lazio coming off one victory in the last 6 matchdays: 3-2 against Genoa at the Olimpico, then 3 draws and 2 defeats in the period.

Only Lecce (14) has missed the appointment with the goal in more matches than Lazio (13) in Serie A 2025/26.

Between Roberto D'Aversa and Maurizio Sarri 6th official encounter: in the 5 precedents the Biancocelesti coach leads 4-1.

Only Yann Sommer and Jean Butez (13) have recorded more clean sheets than Ivan Provedel (12, like Svilar).

Emirhan Ilkhan sent off against Genoa: it is the first red card received by a Torino player in this championship.

Giovanni Simeone at 10 goals against Lazio: it is the team against which he has scored most goals in his career in Italy.



ROMA



JUVENTUS

There have been 99 official meetings in Rome between the two sides: Roma have won 36 (most recently 1-0 in Serie A 2022/23), there have been 34 draws (most recently 1-1 in last season's Serie A) and Juventus have won 29 (most recently 4-3 away in Serie A 2021/22).

In Roma's last 11 home matches against Juventus, **the Giallorossi failed to score only once – the 0-0 draw in Serie A 2017/18.** In the other 10 games, Roma have scored 17 goals.

Roma are the only team in Serie A 2025/26 yet to concede a penalty.

Roma have recorded five wins and one draw in their last six Serie A home matches in 2025/26 (the only draw being 1-1 vs Milan on 25 January 2026). Their last home defeat was 0-1 vs Napoli on 30 November 2025.

Roma are the team that have conceded the fewest goals in Serie A 2025/26 (16).

Juventus are the Serie A 2025/26 team with the fewest yellow cards received (31).

Juventus are the team with the most different goalscorers in Serie A 2025/26 (17).

It will be the 18th official meeting between Gian Piero Gasperini and Luciano Spalletti: Spalletti leads the head-to-head 9-5, with 3 draws.

Gian Piero Gasperini is the ex of the day: he coached in Juventus' youth sector from 1994/95 to 2002/03, winning the Viareggio Tournament in 2003.

Luciano Spalletti is the ex of the day: he coached Roma in two spells – from July 2005 to August 2009, and from January 2016 to June 2017 – winning two Coppa Italia titles and one Supercoppa Italiana. Overall, he recorded 172 wins, 64 draws and 63 defeats in 299 official matches in charge.

Donyell Malen (with five Serie A goals in the 2026 calendar year) **is one of the league's three top scorers since January**, alongside Lautaro Martínez (Inter) and Nikola Krstović (Atalanta).

Niccolò Pisilli scored against Cremonese: it was his seventh goal for Roma, and all seven have come at the Olimpico. He had not scored in Serie A since 7 December 2024 (Roma-Lecce 4-1).

Evan Ndicka scored against Cremonese: it was the Ivorian defender's first Serie A goal. He had not scored in an official match since 24 September 2025, in Nice-Roma in the Europa League.



ROMA



JUVENTUS

No player has made more ball recoveries than Evan Ndicka (185) in Serie A 2025/26.

Bryan Cristante scored against Cremonese: it was the Roma midfielder's second league goal of the season. He had not scored in Serie A since 5 October 2025 (Fiorentina-Roma 1-2).

Cristante also registered a goal and an assist against Cremonese: he had not produced the same return in a single match since 24 February 2025, in Roma-Monza 4-0 (Serie A).

No player has completed more dribbles than Kenan Yıldız (74) in Serie A 2025/26.



PISA



BOLOGNA

In Pisa, there have been 14 official meetings between the two sides: Pisa have won three (most recently 2-0 in the Coppa Italia 1985/86), there have been five draws (most recently 0-0 in Serie B 2007/08) and Bologna have won six (most recently 3-0 away in the Coppa Italia 2019/20).

Pisa have not beaten Bologna at home since 21 August 1985: a 2-0 win in the Coppa Italia, with Pisa goals from Kieft (penalty) and then an own goal by Fabbri.

Pisa have failed to score in their last four home matches against Bologna: their last home goal in this fixture was scored by Neri in the 69th minute of Pisa-Bologna 2-2 in January 1991 (Serie A).

Pisa are the Serie A 2025/26 team that have conceded the most goals in the final 15 minutes of the first half (stoppage time included) (12).

Pisa have recorded only one win in Serie A 2025/26: Pisa-Cremonese 1-0 on 7 November. Since then, across 14 matches, they have posted six draws and nine defeats.

Only Inter (226) have completed more crosses than Pisa (155) in Serie A 2025/26.

No player has won more aerial duels than Idrissa Touré (124) in Serie A 2025/26.

Bologna are among the teams with the most goals scored in the opening 15 minutes in Serie A 2025/26 (10, level with Milan).

Bologna are the Serie A 2025/26 team that have made the most substitutions (129 out of 130 available).

Bologna are coming off four wins in their last five away matches across all competitions; their only defeat was Genoa-Bologna 3-2 in Serie A.

Riccardo Orsolini is among the players who have hit the most goalposts in Serie A 2025/26 (3, level with Kenan Yıldız and Henrikh Mkhitaryan).

It will be the first official meeting between Oscar Hiljemark and Vincenzo Italiano.

Federico Bernardeschi scored against Udinese: it was the Bologna midfielder's second league goal of the season. He had not scored in Serie A since 22 November 2025, also against Udinese, in the 3-0 away win in the reverse fixture.



UDINESE



FIorentINA

The official precedents between the two teams in Friuli are 55 with a record of 19 Udinese victories (latest 1-0, in Serie A 2022/23), 18 draws (latest 0-0, in Serie A 2019/20) and 18 Fiorentina victories (latest 2-3, in Serie A last year).

Udinese coming off 3 consecutive defeats in Serie A: last Friulian victory on 2 February (Udinese-Roma 1-0).

Fiorentina had not won a home match in Serie A since last 4 January (Fiorentina-Cremonese 1-0), also in that case the winning goal by Moise Kean.

Udinese team of Serie A 2025/26 that concedes most goals in the first 15' of the second half (8), like Sassuolo and Fiorentina.

Udinese team of Serie A 2025/26 that scores fewest goals with substitute players (1).

Fiorentina team of Serie A 2025/26 that suffers most fouls (435).

Fiorentina team of Serie A 2025/26 that wins fewest tackles (233).

Between Kosta Runjaic and Paolo Vanoli 4th official encounter: 1 draw and 2 victories for the Viola coach.

Only Evan Ndicka (185) has made more ball recoveries in Serie A 2025/26 than Oumar Solet (181).

Only Kenan Yildiz (74) and Alexis Saelemaekers (68) have completed more dribbles in Serie A 2025/26 than Arthur Atta (62).

Only Nico Paz (94) has attempted more shots in Serie A 2025/26 than Moise Kean (90).

Moise Kean on target against Pisa: 8th goal in this championship for the Azzurri striker. There are three consecutive Serie A matches in which he has hit the target, last championship he had done the same between 3 and 24 November 2024 (11th, 12th and 13th matchday; he had then also scored on the 14th, which however was played on 6 February 2025 due to Super Cup).

Only Erling Haaland (44) and Mason Greenwood (35) have scored more goals than Moise Kean (27, like Jonathan Burkardt) in the top 5 European leagues since the beginning of last season among players born from 1 January 2000.
