



INSIGHTS - MATCHDAY 24

SERIE A ENILIVE 2025/2026



There have been 29 meetings in Verona between the two sides: Verona have won 19 (most recently 1-0 in Serie A 1988/89), there have been eight draws (most recently 1-1 in Serie B 2016/17) and Pisa have won two (most recently 2-0 away in Serie B 1992/93).

The last Serie A meeting between Verona and Pisa at the Bentegodi dates back to 7 May 1989: a 1-0 win for Verona, with Marco Pacione scoring the only goal. Osvaldo Bagnoli was on the Verona bench.

Pisa have not won in Veneto since 18 April 1993 (Verona-Pisa 0-2, Serie B): goals from Christian Vieri and Bosco for the visitors.

Verona are among the teams with the fewest different goalscorers in Serie A 2025/26 (7), level with Parma.

Verona are the team that have dropped the most points in second halves compared with the half-time score (-11). They have also conceded the most goals between the 76th and the 90th minute (stoppage time included)(14).

Verona are on a run of eight Serie A matches without a win: their last victory was a 2-1 win away to Fiorentina on 14 December. Since then, they have recorded two draws and six defeats.

This match features the two worst defences in Serie A 2025/26: Verona have conceded 41 goals, while Pisa have conceded 40 (level with Torino).

Pisa are among the teams awarded the most penalties in Serie A 2025/26 (6), level with Milan.

Pisa have recorded just one win in Serie A 2025/26: a 1-0 victory over Cremonese on 7 November. In the 12 matchdays since, they have posted five draws and seven defeats.

Pisa are the team that have conceded the most goals in the final 15 minutes of the first half (stoppage time included) (11) and also in the final 15 minutes of matches (11). Only Verona have conceded more in the final 15 minutes of the second half.

Verona are the team that have conceded the most goals to opposition substitutes in Serie A 2025/26 (8).

It will be the first official meeting between Paolo Sammarco and Oscar Hiljemark.



GENOA



NAPOLI

There have been 60 official meetings at Marassi between the two sides: Genoa have won 21 (most recently 2-1 in Serie A 2020/21), there have been 21 draws (most recently 2-2 in Serie A 2023/24) and Napoli have won 18 (most recently 2-1 away in Serie A 2024/25).

Since 2012/13, Napoli have lost only once against Genoa (2-1 for the Rossoblù in 2020/21). In the remaining matches they have recorded 16 wins and eight draws (all in Serie A), scoring 48 goals to Genoa's 21.

In the last seven meetings at Marassi, both teams have scored every time: 10 goals for Genoa and 14 for Napoli.

Five of Napoli's last six wins away to Genoa at Marassi have ended 2-1.

Since 2015/16, the top scorer among players currently in the two squads in meetings between Genoa and Napoli at Marassi and the Maradona is Matteo Politano, with three goals.

On 10 June 2007 in Serie B, Genoa and Napoli drew 0-0 at Marassi, a result that mathematically secured promotion to Serie A for both. It was the only season in the second tier with no play-offs, as Genoa held a 10-point lead over the fourth-placed side (Piacenza).

Only Fiorentina (8) have conceded more goals than Genoa (7) in the opening 15 minutes of the second half in Serie A 2025/26.

Napoli are among the teams with the fewest goals scored by substitutes in Serie A 2025/26 (1), level with Udinese and Parma.

It will be the first official meeting between Daniele De Rossi and Antonio Conte.

Daniele De Rossi and Antonio Conte faced each other only once as players: Roma-Juventus 4-0 in Serie A on 8 February 2004.

Vitinha scored against Lazio: it was the Portuguese forward's third league goal this season – his best scoring campaign since moving to Italy (he scored two in each of the previous two seasons, both with Genoa).

Ruslan Malinovskyi has received eight yellow cards: he is joint-most booked player in Serie A 2025/26, level with Marin Pongračić.



GENOA



NAPOLI

Miguel Gutiérrez scored against Fiorentina: it was the Spanish full-back's first goal in Italy. He had not scored since 2 November 2024, in Girona-Leganés 4-3 in LaLiga.

Antonio Vergara scored against Fiorentina: it was his first Serie A goal. He had not scored since 29 March 2025, in Sassuolo-Reggiana 5-1 in Serie B.



FIorentINA



TORINO

There have been 84 official meetings in Florence between the two sides: Fiorentina have won 42 (most recently 1-0 in Serie A 2023/24), there have been 31 draws (most recently 1-1 in Serie A 2024/25) and Torino have won 11 (most recently 1-0 away in Serie A 2022/23).

Fiorentina have failed to score only once in their last 15 home matches against Torino (Fiorentina-Torino 0-1, Serie A 2022/23). In the other 14 games, the Tuscan side scored 25 goals in total.

Fiorentina are the team that have conceded the most goals between the 46th and the 60th minute in Serie A 2025/26 (7), level with Genoa.

Fiorentina have scored in each of their seven official matches in 2026 (nine goals in total). Their last match without scoring was the 0-1 league defeat away to Parma on 27 December.

Only Verona (41) have conceded more goals than Torino in Serie A 2025/26 (40, level with Pisa).

Torino are the only Serie A 2025/26 team with no red cards at all – for or against.

Torino have gone 12 Serie A matchdays without a draw, with a record of four wins and eight defeats. Their last draw was on 8 November, a 0-0 in the Derby della Mole away to Juventus.

It will be the third official meeting between Paolo Vanoli and Marco Baroni: in Torino-Lazio in Serie A 2024/25 (home and away), the current Torino coach recorded one win and one draw.

Paolo Vanoli is the “ex” of the day: he coached Torino in 2024/25, recording 11 wins, 14 draws and 15 defeats across 40 official matches.

Marco Baroni is the “ex” of the day: born in Florence and developed in Fiorentina’s academy as a player, he made three first-team appearances (no goals) in the closing stages of the 1981/82 season.

Manor Solomon scored against Napoli: it was the Israeli’s first-ever Serie A goal. He had not scored in an official match since 23 September 2025, in Sevilla-Villarreal 1-2 in LaLiga.



BOLOGNA



PARMA

The official precedents between the two teams in Bologna are 25: record of 10 Bologna victories (the latest 2-1, in Coppa Italia last 4 December), 10 draws (the latest 0-0, in Serie A 2019/20) and 5 Parma victories (the latest 1-2, in Serie A 2012/13).

Parma has not won at the Dall'Ara since 22 December 2012, 2-1 in Serie A with goals by Valdes and Sansone, after provisional Rossoblù lead with Sorensen.

The historic match par excellence at the Dall'Ara is that of 18 June 2005, when Parma won the second leg of the relegation playoff, 2-0, condemning Bologna to Serie B, who had won the first leg at the Tardini, 1-0. The goals of the Ducali survival were signed by Cardone and Gilardino.

Bologna 2nd team that has scored most between the two halves - between 31' of the first half and 60' of the second - (17), less only than Milan (18). For the Rossoblù it is 43.6% of the total goals in the league, the highest percentage in Serie A 2025/26.

Bologna with only one victory in the last 11 matchdays (Verona-Bologna 2-3, 15 January); subsequently 3 draws and 7 defeats for Bologna, who have collected 6 points in the period. Italiano's team is last for performance in the second half of the season, only 1 point to their credit, like Lecce, Cremonese and Verona.

Parma team that has benefited from the highest number of opponent expulsions in Serie A 2025/26 (5).

Parma team of Serie A 2025/26 that has sent fewest players to score (7), like Verona.

Parma team of Serie A 2025/26 that has scored fewest goals with substitute players (1), like Udinese and Napoli.

Parma team of Serie A 2025/26 that concedes most goals in the first 15' of play (6), like Cremonese.

In 2026 Parma victorious only once in 7 matches (Lecce-Parma 1-2, last 11 January). In the other 6 matches, 3 draws and 3 defeats.

Parma coming off 8 goals conceded in the last 180': considering only the second half of the season, only Pisa (12) has conceded more goals than the Emilians (9, like Bologna).



BOLOGNA



PARMA

Between Vincenzo Italiano and Carlos Cuesta 2nd official encounter, with the only precedent in the first leg of the current Serie A: at the Tardini away victory for the Rossoblù coach, 3-1.

Mateo Pellegrino at 6 goals scored in this Serie A: the Argentine is the top scorer of Parma. His goals have been worth 10 of the 23 points that Parma has collected until today.

No player has won more tackles in Serie A than Mandela Keita (47, like Locatelli).



LECCE



UDINESE

There have been 25 official meetings at the Via del Mare between the two sides: Lecce have won 14 (most recently 1-0 in Serie A 2022/23), there have been two draws (most recently 2-2 in Serie A 2008/09) and Udinese have won nine (most recently 1-0 away in Serie A 2024/25).

Lecce have gone five straight matches without a win against Udinese across the Via del Mare and the Bluenergy Stadium: one draw and four defeats.

Lecce are among the teams that have taken the fewest penalties in Serie A 2025/26 (1), level with Cagliari.

Lecce are the lowest-scoring team in Serie A 2025/26 with 13 goals.

Lecce have been without a win since 12 December (a 1-0 home win over Pisa): in the eight matches since, they have recorded two draws and six defeats.

Lecce have gone 449 minutes without scoring: their last goal was scored by Stulić in the 1st minute of Lecce-Parma 1-2 on 11 January.

Udinese are among the teams with the fewest goals scored by substitutes in Serie A 2025/26 (1), level with Napoli and Parma.

It will be the fourth official meeting between Eusebio Di Francesco and Kosta Runjaić: in the three previous meetings, the Udinese coach leads 2-1.

Eusebio Di Francesco made his Serie A managerial debut against Udinese: Lecce-Udinese 2-0 on 11 September 2011, with goals from Basta and Di Natale.

Jurgen Ekkelenkamp scored against Roma: it was his third Serie A goal of the season, matching his personal best set in 2024/25. All three of his goals in 2025/26 have been match-winning – delivering home wins over Napoli and Roma, and an away win at Torino.

Only Alexis Saelemaekers (63) and Kenan Yıldız (60) have completed more dribbles than Arthur Atta (51) in Serie A 2025/26.

Oumar Solet is the only centre-back in the league's top 20 for successful dribbles (33, 18th, level with Conceição).

No player has made more ball recoveries in Serie A than Oumar Solet (166). Ndicka is second (159).



There have been 11 meetings in Emilia between the two sides: Sassuolo have won five (most recently 1-0 in Serie A 2023/24) and Inter have won six (most recently 2-1 away in Serie A 2022/23).

In the last five meetings at the Mapei Stadium between Sassuolo and Inter, Sassuolo have won only once (1-0 on 4 May 2024). Inter have won the other four, with six goals scored by Sassuolo and 11 by Inter across those games.

Domenico Berardi is the all-time top scorer in Sassuolo-Inter meetings at both the Mapei Stadium and San Siro, with eight goals. Among players in the current squads, Lautaro Martínez is second on that list with five.

At the Mapei Stadium, two of the best fast-starting teams in Serie A 2025/26 go head-to-head: Inter have scored eight goals in the opening 15 minutes, while Sassuolo have scored seven (level with Napoli and Como).

Sassuolo are among the teams that have benefited from the fewest opposition red cards in Serie A 2025/26 (0), level with Torino, Milan, Verona and Lecce.

Inter come into this match on a run of seven straight away wins in official matches across all competitions; their last away defeat was on 26 November (Atlético Madrid-Inter 2-1, Champions League).

Inter have kept a Serie A away clean sheet for 472 minutes: the last goal they conceded away in the league was scored by Vitinha in the 68th minute of Genoa-Inter on 14 December. **Including home matches as well, Inter have not conceded for 247 minutes** (last goal conceded: Moreo in the 23rd minute of Inter-Pisa 6-2 on 23 January).

Inter are the top scorers in Serie A 2025/26 with 52 goals.

Inter have not received a red card after 23 matchdays in Serie A 2025/26, like Cagliari and Torino.

Inter are the team with the most goals scored from outside the box in Serie A (8).

It will be the second official meeting between Fabio Grosso and Cristian Chivu: Inter won the reverse fixture 2-1.

Fabio Grosso is the “ex” of the day: as a player, he made 35 official appearances for Inter, scoring three goals in 2006/07, and won the Scudetto and the Supercoppa Italiana.



Ismaël Koné scored against Pisa: the Canadian midfielder has now reached four Serie A goals, matching his personal best for league goals, set in 2023/24 with Watford in the Championship.

No player has attempted more crosses in Serie A than Federico Dimarco (193); Genoa's Aarón Martín is second (157). The Inter defender has also completed the most crosses (60).



There have been 94 official meetings in Turin between the two sides: Juventus have won 59 (most recently 1-0 in last season's Serie A), there have been 22 draws (most recently 2-2 in Serie A 2021/22) and Lazio have won 13 (most recently 2-1 away in Serie A 2017/18).

Juventus have scored in 16 consecutive home matches against Lazio, for a total of 34 goals. The last time they failed to score was in November 2012, a 0-0 draw in Serie A.

Juventus are among the teams with the most different goalscorers in Serie A 2025/26 (16), level with Cagliari.

Juventus have suffered just one defeat in their last 12 official matches (Cagliari-Juventus 1-0 on 17 January, Serie A); in the other 11, they have recorded nine wins and two draws.

Juventus have kept a home clean sheet for 315 minutes: the last goal they conceded at home was scored by Banda in the 45th minute of Juventus-Lecce 1-1 (Serie A, 3 January).

Lazio are the Serie A 2025/26 team with the most red cards received (7).

Lazio have been unbeaten away from home in official matches since 29 November 2025 (their last away defeat was against Milan at San Siro). In their next four away games, they have recorded two wins and two draws, conceding just one goal (in Udinese-Lazio 1-1 on 27 December, scored by Davis).

It will be the 10th official meeting between Luciano Spalletti and Maurizio Sarri: in the previous nine, Spalletti leads with five wins, with one draw and three wins for Sarri.

Since Luciano Spalletti took charge (first match: Cremonese-Juventus 1-2 on 1 November 2025), only Inter (12) have won more Serie A matches than Juventus (9, level with Milan). Over the same period, the three teams also have the best points totals: Inter 37, Milan 32, Juventus 30.

Since Spalletti's appointment, only Milan (0) and Inter (1) have suffered fewer Serie A defeats than Juventus (2).

Since Spalletti's appointment, only Inter (30) have scored more Serie A goals than Juventus (27). The same applies to goals conceded, with Inter (8) the only team to have conceded fewer than Juventus (9).

Maurizio Sarri is the "ex" of the day: he coached Juventus in 2019/20, taking charge of 52 official matches with a record of 34 wins, nine draws and nine defeats.



Maurizio Sarri, with the scudetto victory in 2019/20, entered history twice: it was the ninth consecutive for Juventus (last championship won by the Bianconeri so far) and he was the oldest coach to have won Serie A single round-robin: born in January 1959, he celebrated in July 2020, at 61 years and 6 months.

No player has touched more balls in the box in Serie A 2025/26 than Kenan Yildiz (129). In second place Lautaro Martínez (115), in third Marcus Thuram (88). The Turkish player is also third in Serie A for shots from inside the box (45), behind Moise Kean (60) and the already mentioned Lautaro Martínez (69).

Gleison Bremer on target against Parma: first brace in Serie A for the Brazilian defender. He had not scored a brace since 28 January 2020 in Milan-Torino in Coppa Italia.

No player suffers more fouls in Serie A than Mattia Zaccagni (68). In second place Marco Palestra (66).



ATALANTA



CREMONESE

In the 23 precedents in Bergamo between the two Lombard teams record of 14 Nerazzurri victories (latest 3-0 in Coppa Italia 2016/17), **7 draws** (latest 1-1 in Serie A 2022/23), **only 2 Grigiorossi victories** (latest 0-3 in Serie B 1987/88).

The last victory of Cremonese in Bergamo dated 22 May 1988, 3-0 in Serie B with goals by Nicoletti, Avanzi and Citterio, all in the final 10' of the match.

Atalanta has not lost in official matches against Cremonese since 6 February 1994, with a 2-0 in favour of the Grigiorossi at the Zini. Since that moment 10 victories for the Nerazzurri and 5 draws in 15 matches played between Serie A, Serie B and Coppa Italia.

In case of a goal against Atalanta, in the matches of the new millennium Jamie Vardy would become the top scorer in the matches between the two teams (1 goal in the first leg match).

In Atalanta-Cremonese of 23 February 1992 in Serie A, the equalising goal in extremis for the Grigiorossi was signed by goalkeeper Michelangelo Rampulla (after the Orobici lead by Bianchezi).

Cremonese team of Serie A 2025/26 that has conceded most goals in the first 15' of play (6, like Parma).

Cremonese without victories for 9 matches: last victory on 7 December 2025 with a 2-0 against Lecce. Since that moment, record of 3 draws and 6 defeats.

Cremonese without goals for 421': last signed by Vardy at 29' of Cremonese-Cagliari 2-2 last 8 January. Furthermore, Grigiorossi goalless away since the 1-3 in Bologna last 1 December, last goal by Vardy at 50'; away drought that amounts to 490'.

Between Raffaele Palladino and Davide Nicola 5th official encounter: in the 4 precedents, 3 victories for the Atalanta coach and 1 for the Cremonese one.

Ahanor sent off against Como: his is the fastest expulsion (7'01") received by Atalanta in Serie A since 4 October 2015, Paletta in Fiorentina-Atalanta at 5'.

Marco Carnesecchi author of 9 saves against Como: in a single match of this Serie A only Arijanet Muric (11) did better in Como-Sassuolo on 28 November 2025.

In Como-Atalanta, two substitute players were then substituted (Addai and Bellanova): it is the first time this happens in this championship.



ROMA



CAGLIARI

The official precedents between the two teams at Roma's home are 48: record of 25 Giallorossi victories (latest 1-0, in Serie A last year), 17 draws (latest 1-1, in Serie A 2019/20) and 6 Cagliari victories (latest 2-4, in Serie A 2012/13).

In the last 9 matches at the Olimpico, Roma always scoring: 17 total goals, last match without goals in the 2013/14 season (Roma-Cagliari 0-0, Serie A).

Cagliari without victories in Rome since 1 February 2013 (Roma-Cagliari 2-4, Serie A): goals by Nainggolan, own goal by Goicoechea, Sau and Pisano for the Sardinians, Totti and Marquinho for Roma.

The Rossoblù team has not scored at the Olimpico for 270': last goal signed by Joao Pedro (90' of Roma-Cagliari 3-2, 23/12/2020, Serie A).

Roma coming off 3 matches without victories considering all competitions: it is the longest streak without victories under the Gasperini management.

Roma (14) team that concedes fewest goals in Serie A 2025/26.

Roma only team of Serie A 2025/26 that has not conceded penalties to opponents.

Cagliari coming off 3 consecutive victories in the league: considering only the second half of the season, it is the second best performance in Serie A (9 points, like Juventus). Better only Inter (10).

Cagliari team of Serie A with fewest penalties in favour (1), like Lecce.

Cagliari team of Serie A 2025/26 that scores most goals with different players (16), like Juventus.

Cagliari without expulsions after 23 matchdays of Serie A, like Torino and Inter.

Between Gian Piero Gasperini and Fabio Pisacane 2nd official encounter: in the only precedent, Cagliari victory (1-0) on the occasion of the first leg match.

Mile Svilar is the goalkeeper with the highest save percentage in Serie A 2025/26 (90.7) - excluding Pietro Terracciano and Filippo Rinaldi, who however count only one full appearance in this championship.



ROMA



CAGLIARI

Only Oumar Solet (166) counts more balls recovered in Serie A after 23 rounds compared to Evan Ndicka (159), the Udinese player however has played 2137 minutes against the 1701 of the Ivorian central defender so far.

Ibrahim Sulemana on target against Verona: first goal in this championship. He had not scored a goal since 17 May 2025 in Genoa-Atalanta 2-3, with the Bergamaschi jersey.

Riyad Idrissi on target against Verona: second goal in this championship. He had not scored a goal since 26 October 2025, precisely in the first leg match against the Scaligeri (2-2 at the Bentegodi).
