SERIE A 2026/2027



SERIE A

Serie A kicks off on 22 August for the 3rd time in history: it also happened in the 2010/11 and 2016/17 seasons. In the first case, the opening matches were Bologna-Fiorentina (1-1) and Siena-Milan (1-2); in the second, Verona-Roma (1-1) and Lazio-Bologna (2-1). Osvaldo (Bologna) scored the opening goal in 2010, while Jankovic (Verona) did so in 2016.

In 2010/11, Milan were crowned Italian champions: Sampdoria, Brescia and Bari were relegated.

In 2016/17, Juventus won their 6th consecutive league title: Empoli, Palermo and Pescara were relegated.



There have been 6 official meetings between the two sides in Milan: 4 Inter wins (the latest a 3-2 victory in Serie A 2024/25) and 2 Monza wins (the latest a 0-1 victory in Serie A 2022/23).

Inter-Monza will be the second official meeting on Matchday 1: the first was Inter-Monza 2-0, with a Lautaro Martinez brace in 2023/24.

Inter are unbeaten in their last 12 official matches: 9 wins and 3 draws, with 33 goals scored. Their last defeat came on 8 March against Milan (1-0).

Inter are unbeaten on Matchday 1 for 7 consecutive seasons: 6 wins and 1 draw. Their last defeat came in 2018/19 against Sassuolo (1-0).

The reigning Serie A champions have not lost their opening league game since 23 August 2015 (Juventus-Udinese 0-1). In the following 10 season openers, the reigning champions have recorded 9 wins and 1 draw.

Monza are winless on Matchday 1: 1 draw (0-0 against Empoli in 2024/25) and 2 defeats (1-2 against Torino in 2022/23 and 2-0 against Inter in 2023/24).

Monza have failed to keep a clean sheet away from home in Serie A in their last 15 official matches: their last clean sheet came on 21 October 2024 (0-3 against Verona).

Monza have reached the Coppa Italia Round of 32: in their first official match of the season, they eliminated Avellino 3-0 at the Brianteo, with a Varela brace and a Forson goal.

Cristian Chivu and Ivan Juric will meet for the first time as coaches in an official match. As players, the record was 2 wins for the Nerazzurri coach and 2 draws across the 2007/08 and 2008/09 seasons. This will be the third official meeting between a Romanian and a Croatian coach, after Chivu-Tudor in Parma-Juventus 1-0 (2024/25) and Juventus-Inter 4-3 (2025/26).

Cristian Chivu is one of 6 coaches to manage a club they previously played for, alongside Aquilani (Sassuolo), Pisacane (Cagliari), Fabregas (Como), Allegri (Napoli) and Abate (Torino).

No player scored more goals than Lautaro Martinez (17) in the 2025/26 season. The last Serie A top scorer to win the scoring title with fewer than 20 goals was Gianluca Vialli (19 goals in 1990/91, when Sampdoria won the league).

No player provided more assists than Federico Dimarco (18) in the 2025/26 season.

No players scored more goals from outside the box than Hakan Çalhanoğlu and Piotr Zieliński (5) in the 2025/26 season.



UDINESE



COMO

There have been 15 official meetings between the two sides in Udine: 7 Udinese wins (the latest a 1-0 victory in Serie A 2024/25), 6 draws (the latest a 0-0 draw in Serie A 2025/26) and 2 Como wins (the latest a 0-1 victory in Serie C 1967/68).

Udinese have not won on Matchday 1 in Serie A since 2019/20 (1-0 against Milan). In the following six openers, they have recorded 3 draws and 3 defeats.

Udinese are making their 32nd consecutive Serie A appearance since 1995/96: during this period, only Inter, Milan, Lazio and Roma have also featured in every season.

Como are making their third consecutive Serie A appearance: this had not happened since the five-season run between 1984/85 and 1988/89.

Como have not scored in Udine for 208 minutes: their last goal was scored by Music in the 3-2 defeat on 19 April 2003, in Serie A.

Como's last win in Udine dates back to 11 February 1968 (1-0 in Serie C, with Giuseppe Cattaneo scoring the decisive goal in the 85th minute).

Udinese have reached the Coppa Italia Round of 32: in their first official match of the season, they eliminated Padova 1-0 at Bluenergy Stadium, with Davis scoring the only goal.

Kosta Runjaic and Cesc Fabregas will meet for the fourth time in an official match: the record stands at 2 wins for the Como coach and 1 draw. This will be the seventh official meeting between a German and a Spanish coach in Serie A: 3 wins for the former, 2 for the latter and 1 draw.

Cesc Fabregas is one of 6 coaches to manage a club they previously played for, alongside Aquilani (Sassuolo), Pisacane (Cagliari), Chivu (Inter), Allegri (Napoli) and Abate (Torino).

Jean Butez and Anastasios Douvikas featured in every Serie A match in 2025/26: 38 appearances out of 38, alongside Svilar (Roma), Adopo and Caprile (Cagliari), Colombo (Genoa), Laurientè (Sassuolo) and Falcone (Lecce).

Only Evan Ndicka (269) and Ylber Ramadani (254) made more recoveries than Oumar Solet (249) in the 2025/26 season.

No player had more shots on target than Nico Paz (46) in the 2025/26 season.

**GENOA****NAPOLI**

There have been 61 official meetings between the two sides at Marassi: 21 Genoa wins (the latest a 2-1 victory in Serie A 2020/21), 21 draws (the latest a 2-2 draw in Serie A 2023/24) and 19 Napoli wins (the latest a 2-3 victory in Serie A 2025/26).

Both teams have scored in each of the last 8 meetings in Genoa: 12 goals for the Rossoblù and 17 for the Azzurri.

Napoli are on a run of 5 consecutive wins at Marassi, 4 of which ended 1-2; last season was the only exception, with a 2-3 win for the Partenopei.

Genoa and Napoli will meet on Matchday 1 of Serie A for the fifth time: a 3-3 draw in 1958/59 and a 1-1 draw in 1954/55 at Marassi, plus Napoli wins in 1957/58 (4-0 at Fuorigrotta) and 1-2 at the Ferraris in 2014/15.

Genoa are winless in their last 4 Serie A openers: their last Matchday 1 win came in 2020/21 (Genoa-Crotone 4-1). Since then, 2 draws and 2 defeats.

Genoa have reached the Coppa Italia Round of 32: a 4-1 home win over Ascoli, with goals from Marcandalli, Baldanzi, Colombo and Havel, after Silipo had given the visitors the lead.

Lorenzo Colombo was one of 8 players to feature in every Serie A match in 2025/26 (38 appearances out of 38), alongside Svilar (Roma), Adopo and Caprile (Cagliari), Butez and Douvikas (Como), Laurientè (Sassuolo) and Falcone (Lecce).

Genoa have missed out on Serie A only once in the last 24 seasons (2022/23), a club record. Daniele De Rossi and Massimiliano Allegri will meet for the fourth time in an official match: in the previous 3 meetings, the Napoli coach recorded 1 win and 2 draws.

Massimiliano Allegri is the former player in focus: he made 7 appearances and scored no goals for Napoli in 1997/98. He is also one of 6 coaches to manage a club they previously played for, alongside Aquilani (Sassuolo), Pisacane (Cagliari), Fabregas (Como), Chivu (Inter) and Abate (Torino).

Only Nico Paz (121) and Nikola Krstović (98) attempted more shots than Scott McTominay (97) in the 2025/26 season.



PARMA



CAGLIARI

There have been 41 meetings between the two sides in Emilia: 20 Parma wins (the latest a 2-1 victory in Serie B 2022/23), 14 draws (the latest a 1-1 draw in Serie A 2025/26) and 7 Cagliari wins (the latest a 2-3 victory in Serie A 2024/25).

Parma have reached the Coppa Italia Round of 32: in their first official match of the season, they eliminated Catania 2-0 at the Tardini, with a Lontani brace.

Parma are winless in their last 8 Serie A openers: their last Matchday 1 win came on 29 August 2010 (Parma-Brescia 2-0). Since then, 2 draws and 6 defeats.

Cagliari have reached the Coppa Italia Round of 32: in their first official match of the season, they eliminated Arezzo 1-0 at the Unipol Domus, with Deiola scoring from the penalty spot.

Cagliari are winless in their last 10 Serie A openers: their last win came on 25 August 2013 (Cagliari-Atalanta 2-1, played at a neutral venue in Trieste). Since then, 6 draws (including the last 5 seasons) and 4 defeats.

Carlos Cuesta and Fabio Pisacane will meet for the third time in an official match: in the previous 2 meetings, both in Serie A 2025/26, Pisacane recorded 1 win and 1 draw.

A meeting between the youngest and fourth-youngest coaches in Serie A 2025/26: Cuesta was born in 1995 and Pisacane in 1986, in January. Between them are Ignazio Abate, also born in 1986 but in November, and Cesc Fabregas, born in 1987.

Carlos Cuesta is one of 6 foreign coaches starting the 2026/27 Serie A season: alongside Amorim (Milan), Juric (Monza), Chivu (Inter), Fabregas (Como) and Runjaic (Udinese).

Carlos Cuesta finished his first Serie A campaign with 11 wins: none came by more than a one-goal margin. 7 wins ended 1-0 and 4 ended 2-1, with more victories away from home than at home: 6 compared to 5.

Fabio Pisacane is one of 6 coaches to manage a club they previously played for, alongside Aquilani (Sassuolo), Chivu (Inter), Fabregas (Como), Allegri (Napoli) and Abate (Torino).

Elia Caprile and Michael Adopo were among the 8 players to feature in every Serie A match in 2025/26: 38 appearances out of 38, alongside Svilar, Colombo, Butez, Douvikas, Falcone and Laurientè.

Only Federico Dimarco (101) and Aarón Martín (70) completed more crosses than Emanuele Valeri (69) in Serie A 2025/26.



There have been 4 meetings between the two sides in Frosinone: all Juventus wins, the latest a 1-2 victory in 2023/24.

Frosinone are making their fourth Serie A appearance: previous campaigns came in 2015/16, 2018/19 and 2023/24.

Frosinone are winless on Matchday 1, with 3 defeats (1-2 against Torino in 2015, 0-4 against Atalanta in 2018 and 1-3 against Napoli in 2023).

Frosinone are unbeaten in official matches since 7 February: 11 wins and 5 draws in 16 games. Their last defeat came against Venezia (1-2, Serie B).

Frosinone have reached the Coppa Italia Round of 32: in their first official match of the season, they eliminated Juve Stabia 4-1 at the Stirpe, with a Kvernadze brace and goals from Cichella and Raimondo.

Juventus are unbeaten on Matchday 1 for 10 consecutive seasons, with 9 wins and 1 draw. Juventus have kept a clean sheet on Matchday 1 for 368 minutes: their last goal conceded came on 22 August 2021 (Udinese-Juventus 2-2, Deulofeu).

Milan and Juventus will both miss out on the 2026/27 Champions League: the last season in which neither side qualified for Europe's premier club competition was 1990/91, when it was still known as the European Cup and Italy had just one spot, reserved for the reigning champions, Sampdoria under Boskov.

Massimiliano Alvini and Luciano Spalletti will meet for the second time in an official match: in the only previous meeting, the Juventus coach won (Cremonese-Napoli 1-4 in 2023/24).

Massimiliano Alvini is embarking on his second Serie A spell: in his first season, at Cremonese in 2023/24, he managed 18 matches, recording 7 draws and 11 defeats.

Only Nico Paz (46) had more shots on target than Kenan Yildiz (40) in the 2025/26 season.

No player completed more dribbles than Kenan Yildiz (102) in the 2025/26 season.

No player completed more passes than Manuel Locatelli (2,524) in the 2025/26 season..



VENEZIA



LECCE

There have been 18 official meetings between the two sides in Venice: 7 Venezia wins (the latest a 2-1 victory in the Serie B 2020/21 playoffs), 8 draws (the latest a 1-1 draw in Serie B 2018/19) and 3 Lecce wins (the latest a 0-1 victory in Serie A 2024/25).

Venezia are on a run of 8 consecutive home wins: across the final part of last season in Serie B and last week's Coppa Italia, Venezia have won every game at the Penzo. The last team to leave the Penzo with points was Modena, who won 2-0 on 10 February in Serie B.

Venezia have reached the Coppa Italia Round of 32: in their first official match of the season, they eliminated Modena 3-2 at the Penzo, with Adams scoring twice and Yeboah also finding the net for the hosts, while Ambrosino scored a brace for the Canarini.

Venezia have not won their Serie A opener in 86 years: their last victory came on 6 October 1940, a 1-0 home win over Inter. Since then, they have recorded 3 draws and 9 defeats in their following 12 openers.

Venezia are celebrating their third promotion from Serie B to Serie A in the last 5 years: after promotions in 2020/21 and 2023/24, the Lagunari returned to the top flight in 2025/26. Venezia have not played two consecutive Serie A seasons since 1998/99-1999/00, when Giuseppe Marotta was the club's general manager.

Lecce were eliminated in the Coppa Italia Round of 32: in their first official match of the season, they lost 2-0 to Palermo at the Barbera, with goals from Vavassori and Pohjanpallo. Alongside Lazio, Lecce are one of only two Serie A sides already out of the competition.

Lecce have failed to win their Serie A opener in 6 of their 7 appearances: their only victory came on 20 August 2023, a 2-1 home win over Lazio.

Lecce are entering their fifth consecutive Serie A season: promoted from Serie B in summer 2022, the Salentini are enjoying the longest top-flight run in their recent history. Banda's goal in May's win over Genoa was Lecce's 700th in Serie A.

Giovanni Stroppa and Eusebio Di Francesco will meet for the third time in an official match: the current Lecce coach won both previous meetings (Crotone-Sampdoria 1-3 in the 2019/20 Coppa Italia and Cagliari-Crotone 4-2 in Serie A 2020/21).

Giovanni Stroppa returns to Serie A after 3 years: the Venezia coach makes his comeback against Lecce, the team he faced in his last Serie A match as a coach (Monza-Lecce 1-1, 17 September 2023).



VENEZIA



LECCE

Eusebio Di Francesco is the former player/coach in focus: he managed Venezia in 2024/25, the Lagunari's last Serie A season before their latest promotion. His record was 5 wins, 14 draws and 20 defeats in 39 official matches.

Only Victor Nelsson won more aerial duels than Tiago Gabriel in Serie A 2025/26: 154 for the Danish defender compared to 152 for the Lecce centre-back.

Wladimiro Falcone was among the 8 players to feature in every Serie A match in 2025/26: 38 appearances out of 38, alongside Svilar, Colombo, Butez, Douvikas, Laurientè, Caprile and Adopo.



ATALANTA



SASSUOLO

There have been 17 official meetings between the two sides in Bergamo: 13 home wins for Atalanta (the latest a 3-0 victory in Serie A 2023/24), 2 draws (the latest a 1-1 draw in Serie A 2016/17) and 2 Sassuolo wins (the latest a 0-3 victory in Serie A 2025/26).

Atalanta-Sassuolo will be played on Matchday 1 of Serie A for the second time in their history: on 20 August 2023, Atalanta won 2-0 at the Mapei, with Zortea and De Ketelaere scoring late. That season, Sassuolo were relegated to Serie B for the first time in their history.

Atalanta are entering their 66th Serie A season: the Bergamaschi move into the top ten clubs with the most appearances in Italy's top flight, level with Sampdoria.

Atalanta are unbeaten in their last 8 Serie A openers: 7 wins and 1 draw, with their last defeat coming on 20 August 2017, at home against Roma (0-1).

Armand Laurientè is one of 8 players to feature in all 38 rounds of Serie A 2025/26, alongside Svilar (Roma), Colombo (Genoa), Butez and Duvvika (Como), Falcone (Lecce), Caprile and Adopo (Cagliari).

Sassuolo have not picked up points on Matchday 1 in Serie A since 21 August 2021: a 3-2 win at Verona, followed by 3 defeats in their next 3 openers without scoring. Their last goal in those 3 matches was scored by Hamed Traorè in the 79th minute at Verona, with the drought now standing at 281 minutes.

Sassuolo have reached the Coppa Italia Round of 32: a 3-0 home win over Cesena, with goals from Volpato, Adzic and Lipani.

Sassuolo are entering their 13th Serie A season: among cities that are not provincial capitals, only Empoli (17) have played more Serie A seasons. Sassuolo will equal the number of Serie A appearances made by Modena, the capital of their province.

Considering all official matches played, **Atalanta have scored more goals against Sassuolo than any other Serie A team: 61.**

Sassuolo finished 11th in Serie A 2025/26: collecting 49 points. For the fourth consecutive year, a newly promoted side avoided relegation comfortably: Monza finished on 52 points in 2022/23, followed by Genoa, Como and Sassuolo, all with 49 points, from 2023/24 onwards.

Maurizio Sarri and Alberto Aquilani will meet for the first time in an official match.

**ATALANTA****SASSUOLO**

Maurizio Sarri is the oldest coach to have won the Scudetto in the single-round Serie A era: he achieved it with Juventus in 2019/20, aged just under 61 years and 7 months.

Alberto Aquilani is making his Serie A coaching debut: alongside him, Amorim (Milan), Abate (Torino) and Tedesco (Bologna) will also be making their Serie A debuts.

Alberto Aquilani is one of 6 coaches to manage a club they previously played for, alongside Chivu (Inter), Pisacane (Cagliari), Fabregas (Como), Allegri (Napoli) and Abate (Torino).

No player produced more xG than Nikola Krstović (15.26) in the 2025/26 season.



There have been 93 official meetings between the two sides in Turin: 34 Torino wins (the latest a 2-1 victory in Serie A 2024/25), 39 draws (the latest a 0-0 draw in Serie A 2021/22) and 20 Milan wins (the latest a 2-3 victory in Serie A 2025/26).

Torino and Milan will meet on Matchday 1 of Serie A for the fourth time: 1 Torino win (a 2-1 home victory in 1939/40) and 2 Milan wins (3-2 at San Siro in 2016/17 and 2-2, again in Milan, in 2024/25).

Torino have reached the Coppa Italia Round of 32: a 1-0 home win over Carrarese, with Giovanni Simeone scoring the decisive goal.

Torino are unbeaten in their last 7 official home matches: across the end of last season and the start of the new one, they have recorded 5 wins and 2 draws. Their last defeat came on 15 February (Torino-Bologna 1-2, Serie A).

Torino have been without European football since the 2019/20 season: in 2018/19, the Granata finished 7th with 63 points and entered the Europa League qualifying rounds the following season.

Milan and Juventus will both miss out on the 2026/27 Champions League: the last season in which neither side qualified for Europe's premier club competition was 1990/91, when the tournament was still known as the European Cup.

Ignazio Abate, who made 27 appearances and scored 1 goal in 2008/09, is one of 6 coaches to manage a club they previously played for, alongside Aquilani (Sassuolo), Pisacane (Cagliari), Fabregas (Como) and Allegri (Napoli).

Ignazio Abate is the former player in focus: he made 306 official appearances for Milan, scoring 3 goals across 2003/04 and from 2008/09 to 2018/19, winning 2 Serie A titles and 2 Supercoppa Italiana trophies.

Ruben Amorim is the fifth Portuguese-born coach in Serie A: before him came José Mourinho (Inter and Roma), Paulo Sousa (Fiorentina and Salernitana), Paulo Fonseca (born in Mozambique, formerly of Roma) and Sérgio Conceição (Milan).

Ignazio Abate and Ruben Amorim will meet for the first time in an official match: they are two of the four coaches making their Serie A debuts in 2026/27, alongside Tedesco (Bologna) and Aquilani (Sassuolo).



TORINO



MILAN

Cesare Casadei has scored 6 Serie A goals since January: he is the most prolific Italian player in the league in the calendar year, level with Pio Esposito.

Only Kenan Yildiz (102) completed more dribbles than Alexis Saelemaekers (85) in the 2025/26 season.



There have been 81 official meetings between the two sides in Emilia: 44 Bologna wins (most recent 5-0, Serie A 2024/25), 20 draws (most recent 1-1, Coppa Italia 2025/26, with Lazio advancing on penalties) and 17 Lazio wins (most recent 2-0, Serie A 2025/26).

Bologna-Lazio will be played on the opening matchday of Serie A for the 7th time in history: 3 Lazio wins (1929, 2015 and 2022/23), 1 draw (1959/60) and 2 Bologna wins (1960/61 and 1996/97). The first meeting dates back to 1929, on the inaugural matchday of the first Serie A season played as a single round-robin league, with Lazio winning 3-0 in Rome.

Bologna have finished in the top half of the table for 4 consecutive seasons: a feat the Emilia-based club had not achieved since the 1960s.

Lazio eliminated in the Coppa Italia Round of 32: in their first official match of the season, they were beaten 2-0 by Mantova at the Olimpico, with goals from Ruocco and Cajazzo. Alongside Lecce, Lazio are one of two Serie A sides already out of the competition.

Lazio have failed to qualify for European competitions for 2 consecutive seasons: this had not happened to the Biancocelesti since the early 1990s.

Domenico Tedesco and Gennaro Gattuso will meet for the first time in an official match: the two coaches, both from the province of Cosenza, have never faced each other in their careers.

Domenico Tedesco is making his Serie A debut: Amorim (Milan), Abate (Torino) and Aquilani (Sassuolo) are also making their debut in Italy's top flight.

Gennaro Gattuso returns to a Serie A dugout after more than 5 years: his last match was on 23 May 2021, Napoli-Verona 1-1.



ROMA



FIORENTINA

There have been 101 official meetings between the two sides in Rome: 50 Roma wins (most recent 4-0, Serie A 2025/26), 32 draws (most recent 1-1, Serie A 2023/24) and 19 Fiorentina wins (most recent 2-0, Serie A 2017/18).

Fiorentina have not beaten Roma at the Olimpico since 7 April 2018 (Roma-Fiorentina 0-2, Serie A, goals from Benassi and Simeone): in the following 8 meetings, Roma have recorded 6 wins and there have been 2 draws.

Roma and Fiorentina meet on the opening matchday for the 11th time: in the previous 10 meetings (8 in Rome and 2 in Florence), Roma have won 6 times and Fiorentina 4. In 1968/69, Fiorentina won 2-1 at home and went on to win their second and most recent Scudetto at the end of the season.

Roma finished 3rd in Serie A 2025/26: the Giallorossi return to the Champions League, having last appeared in the competition in 2018/19. Roma had not finished 3rd in Serie A since 2017/18, with Di Francesco in charge.

Roma are unbeaten in their last 7 Serie A matches: 6 wins and 1 draw. Their last defeat came against Inter on 5 April 2026 (Inter-Roma 5-2).

Roma have avoided defeat on the pitch on the opening matchday of Serie A since 11 September 2011 (Roma-Cagliari 1-2): since then, 8 wins and 6 draws. In 2020/21, Roma drew 0-0 away to Verona, but the result was subsequently changed to a 0-3 defeat by the Sporting Judge due to the improper selection of Diawara, who had not been included in the club's Under-22 list.

Roma have scored in 17 consecutive Serie A matches: 36 goals scored during this run, with their last goalless outing coming on 2 February 2026 (Udinese-Roma 1-0).

Roma have scored in 15 consecutive home matches in all competitions: 33 goals scored during this run, with their last goalless game coming on 30 November 2025 (Roma-Napoli 0-1, Serie A).

Fiorentina are making their 89th appearance in Serie A since the introduction of the single-round format: they are the 5th Italian club with the most top-flight appearances, behind only Inter (94), Juventus and Roma (93), and Milan (92).

Fiorentina finished 15th in Serie A 2025/26: 42 points collected, their lowest finish since 2020/21 (13th place with 40 points). No team had ever survived after failing to win any of their first 15 matches.



ROMA



FIORENTINA

Fiorentina have been unbeaten on the opening matchday since 2021/22: their last defeat came against Roma (Roma-Fiorentina 3-1), with a brace from Veretout, Mkhitarian and Milenkovic scoring for the Viola.

Fiorentina have won 8 of their last 9 official matches in all competitions: 4 wins and 4 draws. Their only defeat came against Roma (Roma-Fiorentina 4-0, Serie A).

Fiorentina advanced to the Coppa Italia Round of 16: in their first official match of the season, they eliminated Benevento with a 4-1 win at the Franchi, with goals from Gudmundsson, Kean, Ranieri and Ndour for the Viola, and Lamesta for the visitors.

Gian Piero Gasperini and Fabio Grosso will meet for the 4th time in an official match: in the previous 3 meetings, the current Roma manager has won all three. Grosso's teams have never scored in the 270 minutes played.

Gian Piero Gasperini is the longest-serving coach in Serie A 2026/27: born in 1958, he is the coach with the most Serie A appearances on the bench (637), just 7 behind 4th place in the all-time rankings for Serie A since the introduction of the single-round format, currently held by Nils Liedholm, who won Roma's second Scudetto in 1982/83.

No player has scored more Serie A goals than Donyell Malen (14) in the 2026 calendar year.

Mile Svilar played every minute of Serie A 2025/26: 38 appearances out of 38, alongside Laurientè (Sassuolo), Colombo (Genoa), Butez and Douvikas (Como), Falcone (Lecce), Caprile and Adopo (Cagliari).

No player made more recoveries than Evan Ndicka (269) in the 2025/26 season.

No player scored more headed goals than Mateo Pellegrino (6) in the 2025/26 season.

Only Nikola Krstović recorded a higher xG total (15.2) than Moise Kean (14.9) in the 2025/26 season.

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
