



INSIGHTS - MATCHDAY 25

SERIE A 2025/2026



In Pisa, there have been nine official meetings between the two sides: just one draw (0-0 in Serie A 1983/84) and eight Milan wins (most recently 1-0 away in Serie A 1990/91).

Across those nine games, Pisa have scored only twice: in the 2-1 defeats in the Coppa Italia 1979/80 and in Serie A 1987/88 (3-1).

Pisa are the Serie A 2025/26 team that have conceded the most goals in the final 15 minutes of the first half (stoppage time included) (11).

This match pits the team with the fewest wins in Serie A 2025/26 (Pisa, 1 – a 1-0 win over Cremonese at the Arena on 7 November) against the team with the fewest defeats (Milan, 1 – also against Cremonese, who won 2-1 at San Siro on Matchday 1).

Pisa are the team with the fewest home goals scored in Serie A 2025/26 (3).

Pisa are among the teams with the fewest home points in Serie A 2025/26 (7), level with Verona.

Pisa and Milan are among the teams awarded the most penalties in Serie A 2025/26 (6, level with Como and Genoa). **Milan are also among the teams that have conceded the most penalties (7,** level with Napoli).

Milan are the only Serie A 2025/26 team unbeaten away from home: their last away defeat was the 3-1 loss at Roma's Olimpico on 18 May 2025.

Milan are the team that have gained the most points in second halves compared with the half-time score (+13) in Serie A 2025/26.

Milan are the team that have scored the most goals in the opening 15 minutes of the second half in Serie A 2025/26 (10).

It will be the first official meeting between Oscar Hiljemark and Massimiliano Allegri.

Massimiliano Allegri is the ex of the day: as a player, he made his Serie A debut on 11 June 1989 for Pisa against Milan (0-2, Van Basten brace). He came on for Martini in the 88th minute.

Ruben Loftus-Cheek scored against Bologna: it was the English midfielder's second league goal of the season. He had not scored since Matchday 2 (Lecce-Milan 0-2, 29 August 2025).



Christopher Nkunku scored against Bologna: it was the French forward's fifth league goal of the season. He had not scored at least five goals in a single league campaign since 2022/23 (when he scored 16 in the Bundesliga for RB Leipzig).

Adrien Rabiot scored against Bologna: it was the French midfielder's fourth league goal of the season. He had not recorded a goal and an assist in the same match since 1 December 2023, in Monza-Juventus 1-2 (Serie A).

FIorentINA

There are 16 official precedents in Como between the two teams: record of 7 Lariani victories (latest 2-0, Coppa Italia 2001/02), 5 draws (latest 0-0, Serie A 1986/87) and 4 Viola victories (the latest 0-2, Serie A 2024/25).

Como without goals at home against the Viola for 208': the last signed by Pedone at 62' of Como-Fiorentina 2-0, Coppa Italia, October 2001.

Como arrives at this match after the recent victory in the quarter-finals of Coppa Italia against Napoli. For the Lariani exactly forty years have passed since the last appearance in the semi-final of the competition (Sampdoria-Como in the 1985/86 season, progression of the Doriani by virtue of the 1-1 draw in Genoa and the 0-2 forfeit victory on the occasion of the second leg in Como).

Como team with most penalties in favour in Serie A 2025/26 (6), like Pisa, Genoa and Milan.

Only Inter (24) and Juventus (19) have scored more goals than Como in the last 30 minutes plus stoppage time in Serie A 2025/26 (18).

Como coming off only one defeat in the last 10 official matches, against 6 victories and 3 draws. The only negative result on the occasion of the home match against Milan (1-3 last 15 January).

Only Pisa (11) and Verona (14) concede more goals in the last 15 minutes plus stoppage time than Fiorentina (9) in Serie A 2025/26.

Fiorentina always scoring in the 8 official matches of 2026: 11 Tuscan goals in the period, the last match without goals in Parma (Parma-Fiorentina 1-0, last 27 December in the league).

Between Cesc Fabregas and Paolo Vanoli 4th official encounter: in the 3 precedents no draw with the Spaniard ahead with 2 victories to 1.

Rolando Mandragora at 6 goals in the league: he has already surpassed his best previous result in his career (4 goals in the 2024/25 season, also with Fiorentina). The midfielder is also the top scorer in the league for Fiorentina (6 goals also for Moise Kean).

Manor Solomon on target in both of the last 2 league matchdays: he had not scored a goal in two consecutive matchdays of a league since last April (with the Leeds jersey in Championship, goals against Preston and Oxford in matchdays 42 and 43 of the tournament).

No player has attempted more shots than Nico Paz in Serie A 2025/26 (53), followed by Moise Kean (84) and Lautaro Martínez (81).

The Como playmaker is also the player who has attempted most shots from outside the box (53), in second place Hakan Çalhanoglu and Ruslan Malinovskyi (35). Only Hakan Çalhanoglu (4) has scored more goals from outside in this Serie A compared to Nico Paz and Rolando Mandragora (3, like Piotr Zieliński).

Only Kenan Yildiz and Riccardo Orsolini (4) have hit the woodwork more than Nico Paz and Moise Kean (3) in Serie A.



LAZIO



ATALANTA

The official matches in Rome between the two teams are 64: record of 28 Lazio victories (latest 3-2, Serie A 2023/24), 21 draws (latest 1-1, Serie A 2024/25) and 15 Bergamo victories (latest 1-4, Serie A 2022/23).

Lazio has won only 1 time at home against Atalanta in the last 8 official matches: the 3-2 of Serie A 2023/24. Remaining record of 3 victories for the Orobici and 3 draws, with 10 goals scored and 16 conceded.

Considering the players present in the current squads, since the 2015/16 season Charles De Ketelaere is the top scorer in the matches in Rome between Lazio and Atalanta, with 2 goals.

Lazio team of Serie A 2025/26 that has suffered most expulsions: 7.

Lazio coming off only one defeat in the last 6 league matchdays: Lazio-Como 0-3 on 19 January. In the period considered, 2 victories and 3 draws.

Atalanta with the second best performance in Serie A in the second half of the season: 11 points for the Bergamaschi after 5 matchdays of the second part of the tournament. Nerazzurri unbeaten in the league for 7 rounds (5 victories and 2 draws, last defeat at home against Inter, 0-1, last 28 December).

Atalanta without goals in the last 2 official away matches: Union St. Gilloise-Atalanta 1-0 (Champions League) and Como-Atalanta 0-0 in Serie A.

Between Maurizio Sarri and Raffaele Palladino 4th official encounter: Biancocelesti coach unbeaten with 2 victories and 1 draw.

Pedro on target against Juventus: third goal in this championship for the Spanish striker and second consecutive after the goal against Genoa. He had not scored for two matches in a row since 27 October-31 October 2024 (Lazio-Genoa 3-0 and Como-Lazio 1-5, in Serie A).

Gustav Isaksen on target against Juventus: third goal in this championship for the Danish striker. He had not scored a goal in official matches since 7 December (Lazio-Bologna 1-1). It is the first away goal in this Serie A, the last on 6 April 2025 in Atalanta-Lazio 0-1.

Davide Zappacosta on target against Cremonese: first goal in this championship for the Orobico defender. He had not scored a goal since 9 March 2025 in Juventus-Atalanta 0-4.



LAZIO



ATALANTA

Nikola Krstovic on target against Cremonese: seventh goal in this championship for the Montenegrin striker. He has equalled his goals from his first season in Italy (2023/24, with the Lecce jersey, in 35 appearances).

Nikola Krstovic at 5 goals scored in the calendar year 2026 in Serie A: no one has scored more (5 also for Lautaro Martinez).



There are 114 official precedents of the Derby d'Italia in Milan: 46 Inter victories (latest 1-0, Serie A 2023/24), 36 draws (latest 4-4, Serie A 2024/25) and 32 Juventus victories (latest 0-1, Serie A 2022/23).

Facing at the Giuseppe Meazza the two teams that have scored most headed goals in this Serie A (12 for Inter, 9 for Juventus) and that score most goals with different players (16, like Cagliari).

Inter unbeaten for 12 matches in Serie A (record of 11 victories and 1 draw): last defeat in the derby against Milan last 23 November (0-1, goal by Pulisic).

Inter (57) team that scores most goals in Serie A 2025/26: record in 3 match intervals, 9 goals from 1' to 15', 9 from 31' to 45' including stoppage time and 14 from 76' to 90' including stoppage time.

Inter one of the 3 teams of Serie A 2025/26 without players sent off, like Torino and Cagliari.

Against Lazio, Juventus obtained their 23rd draw in the last 2 seasons in Serie A: no team has collected more in the period considering the top 5 European leagues (23 also for Brighton and Parma).

Juventus coming off 3 away matches without goals in the last 4 official away matches in all competitions: with the exception of the away match in Parma (1-4 in Serie A), no goals in Cagliari (Cagliari-Juventus 1-0, Serie A), in Monaco (Monaco-Juventus 0-0, Champions League) and in Bergamo (Atalanta-Juventus 3-0, Coppa Italia).

Between Cristian Chivu and Luciano Spalletti first official encounter.

Luciano Spalletti ex of the matchday: the Tuscan coach led the Nerazzurri in the 2017/18 and 2018/19 seasons, totalling 90 benches in official matches, with a score of 45 victories, 26 draws and 19 defeats, bringing Inter back to Champions League after 6 seasons of absence from the major European club competition.

Lautaro Martinez at 5 goals scored in the calendar year 2026 in Serie A: no one has scored more (5 also for Nikola Krstovic).

Federico Dimarco at 13 seasonal assists in Serie A: the Inter defender has almost doubled his best career record in a single championship (7 in the 2024/25 season).



3 assists against Sassuolo for Federico Dimarco: it is the second time this season that an Inter player is the protagonist of 3 decisive passes in a single match (Bonny in Inter-Cremonese 4-1, 4/10/2025). Before this episode, the most recent individual performance of this level in Serie A dated back to 30 April 2023: 3 assists by Luka Jovic in Fiorentina-Sampdoria 5-0.

Against Sassuolo, first career goal in Serie A for Luis Henrique and Manuel Akanji: the Swiss defender had not scored a goal in official matches since 5 September 2025 in Switzerland-Kosovo 4-0 in the World Cup Qualifications; with clubs instead since 6 March 2024 in Manchester City-Copenhagen 3-1 in Champions League.

Weston McKennie on target against Lazio: 7th seasonal goal considering all competitions for the American midfielder, who has thus surpassed his previous record (6 in the 2020/21 season, also with Juventus).

Pierre Kalulu on target against Lazio: 2nd seasonal goal for the Juventus defender in Serie A, best result in his career in a single championship.



UDINESE



SASSUOLO

There are 11 precedents in Friuli between the two teams: 4 home victories (latest 3-2, in Serie A 2021/22), 4 draws (latest 2-2, Serie A 2023/24) and 3 Neroverdi victories (latest 2-1, Serie A 2017/18).

Udinese has lost only 1 time (Sassuolo-Udinese 3-1, in the first leg) in the last 13 matches against Sassuolo, against 5 victories for the Friulani and 7 draws.

Udinese scoring for 8 consecutive home matches against the Emilians: in the period 15 Bianconeri goals.

Among the players present in the current squads, the top scorer in the matches between Udinese and Sassuolo is Domenico Berardi, with 3 goals.

Sassuolo coming off the home defeat against Inter (0-5, 24th matchday of Serie A): the Neroverdi had not conceded 5 goals in the same match since 6 April 2025, Palermo-Sassuolo 5-3 in Serie B.

With the expulsion of Nemanja Matic in Sassuolo-Inter, the Neroverdi received their second red card in this championship (Sassuolo-Napoli 0-2 on 23 August 2025, 1st matchday).

Udinese team of Serie A 2025/26 that scores least with substitute players (1, like Napoli).

Sassuolo team of Serie A 2025/26 that concedes most goals (8) in the first 15' of the second half.

Between Kosta Runjaic and Fabio Grosso 2nd official encounter: only precedent the Sassuolo victory 3-1 in the first leg at the Mapei Stadium.

Oumar Solet on target against Lecce: 2nd goal in the league for the Bianconeri defender and first penalty converted in his career. He had not scored a goal in Serie A since 21 December 2025 in Fiorentina-Udinese 5-1.

Nemanja Matic sent off against Inter: first expulsion since playing in Italy. He had not received a red card since 29 January 2020 in Manchester City-Manchester United 0-1, in the English League Cup.



There are 30 official precedents in Parma between the two teams: record of 13 Emilian victories (latest 1-0, Serie A 2020/21), 7 draws (latest 2-2, Serie A 2014/15) and 10 Scaligeri victories (latest 3-2, Serie A 2024/25).

Before Verona-Pisa, the Scaligeri had not kept a clean sheet in a home match in Serie A since 15 September 2025 (Verona-Cremonese 0-0, 3rd matchday).

Facing at the Tardini the two teams of Serie A 2025/26 that score the fewest goals with different players: 8 for the Emilians, 7 for the Scaligeri.

Only Lecce (15) scores fewer goals than Parma (16) and Verona (18) in Serie A 2025/26.

Parma team of Serie A 2025/26 that benefits from the highest number of expulsions of opponent players (6).

In Bologna-Parma last weekend at least one expulsion was recorded for both teams: it had not happened since the 18th matchday of Serie A (Lazio-Napoli 0-2, in that case Marusic, Noslin and Mazzocchi). These are the only two matches in which this situation has occurred in Serie A 2025/26.

Parma coming off only one victory in the last 10 home matches in Serie A (Parma-Fiorentina 1-0, 27/12/2025). In the remaining 9 matches, record of 3 draws and 6 defeats.

Verona team of Serie A 2025/26 that benefits from the lowest number of opponent expulsions (0, like Lecce, Torino, Milan and Sassuolo).

Verona team of Serie A 2025/26 that concedes most goals from substitute players (8).

Verona team of Serie A 2025/26 that loses most points in the second halves compared to the results at 45' (-11).

Verona without victories for 9 matchdays of Serie A: 3 draws and 6 defeats in the period. Last victory 1-2 in Florence last 14 December.

Verona without scoring goals for 244': last signed by Orban at 24' of Verona-Udinese 1-3 last 26 January.

Between Carlos Cuesta and Paolo Sammarco first official encounter.



PARMA



VERONA

Christian Ordonez on target against Bologna: 1st goal in Serie A for the Argentine midfielder. He had not scored a goal in official matches since 7 August 2024 in San Lorenzo-Velez Sarsfield in Copa Argentina.



There have been 11 official meetings in Cremona between the two sides: Cremonese have won four (most recently 2-1 in Serie B 1996/97), there have been four draws (most recently 1-1 in Serie B 1998/99) and Genoa have won three (most recently 1-0 in Serie A 1989/90).

This will be the first official meeting between the teams in the 21st century: the last match in Cremona dates back to 11 April 1999, a 1-1 draw in Serie B, with Ghirardello scoring in the 1st minute for the hosts and Francioso equalising in the 33rd for Genoa.

Cremonese's last win in this fixture came on 14 September 1996 in Serie B: a 2-1 victory, with goals from Maspero and Mirabelli for Cremonese, while Masolini scored a penalty for Genoa.

The teams have not met in Serie A since 1994/95: Cremonese won 4-1 at home on 23 April 1995, with braces from Chiesa (including a penalty) and Tentoni; Genoa's consolation goal was scored by Marcolin from the penalty spot.

Genoa have not won in Cremona since 10 September 1989: their last success was a 1-0 win in Serie A, decided by a penalty from Aguilera.

Cremonese have been without a league win since 7 December (a 2-0 home win over Lecce at the Zini). In the 10 matchdays since, they have recorded three draws and seven defeats.

Cremonese have gone 241 minutes without scoring at home: their last goal at the Zini was scored by Vardy in the 29th minute of Cremonese-Cagliari 2-2 on 8 January.

Cremonese are the Serie A 2025/26 team that have conceded the most goals in the opening 15 minutes (7).

Cremonese are among the teams with the fewest points won in the second half of the season (1), level with Bologna.

Genoa are among the teams awarded the most penalties in Serie A 2025/26 (6), level with Pisa, Como and Milan.

Genoa are coming off three straight matches ending 3-2: a win over Bologna at Marassi, followed by defeats away to Lazio in Rome and at the Ferraris against Napoli.



It will be the third official meeting between Davide Nicola and Daniele De Rossi: the Cremonese coach is unbeaten, with one win and one draw. The win came on the final matchday of Serie A 2023/24 – Empoli-Roma 2-1 on 26 May 2024 – a result that secured mathematical safety for Empoli thanks to Niang’s stoppage-time winner, after Cancellieri’s opener and Aouar’s equaliser.

Davide Nicola is the ex of the day: as a player, he wore the Genoa shirt from 1995/96 to 2001/02 (with a spell at Pescara in 1998/99), making 183 official appearances and scoring four goals. In 1995/96, he won the Anglo-Italian Cup with Genoa, playing the first 50 minutes of the Wembley final – a 5-2 win over Port Vale – before being replaced by Van’t Schip. He later coached Genoa from January to August 2020, recording eight wins, five draws and nine defeats across 22 official matches in charge.

Morten Thorsby scored against Atalanta: it was the Norwegian midfielder’s third league goal of the season and his first for Cremonese. The goal ended a 514-minute scoring drought for Nicola’s side.

Lorenzo Colombo scored against Napoli: it was the Italian striker’s sixth league goal of the season, equalling his personal best for goals in a single campaign (set in 2024/25 with Empoli in Serie A and in 2021/22 with SPAL in Serie B).

Ruslan Malinovskyi scored against Napoli: it was the Ukrainian midfielder’s fifth Serie A goal of the season. He had not scored five or more goals in a single league campaign since 2021/22 (when he scored six for Atalanta).



TORINO



BOLOGNA

There have been 72 official meetings in Turin between the two sides: Torino have won 38 (most recently 1-0 in Serie A 2022/23), there have been 23 draws (most recently 0-0 in Serie A 2023/24) and Bologna have won 11 (most recently 2-0 away in Serie A 2024/25).

Torino have gone five matches without a win against Bologna across the Olimpico and the Dall'Ara: three Bologna wins and two draws.

Among players in the current squads, **Riccardo Orsolini is the top scorer in Torino-Bologna meetings, with three goals.**

Only Lazio (7) have received more red cards than Bologna (5) in Serie A 2025/26.

Torino are the team that have conceded the most goals in Serie A 2025/26 (42).

Only Inter (9) have scored more goals than Bologna (8) in the final 15 minutes of the first half (stoppage time included) in Serie A 2025/26.

Only Milan (10) have scored more goals than Bologna (9) in the opening 15 minutes of the second half in Serie A 2025/26.

Bologna are among the teams with the fewest points won in the second half of the season (1), level with Cremonese.

Bologna have recorded only one win in their last 11 matchdays (Verona-Bologna 2-3 on 15 January 2026). In the other 10, they have posted three draws and seven defeats.

In Bologna-Parma last weekend, both teams received at least one red card – something that had not happened in the same match since Matchday 18 (Lazio-Napoli 0-2, when Marušić, Noslin and Mazzocchi were sent off). These are the only two matches in Serie A 2025/26 in which this has occurred.

It will be the eighth official meeting between Marco Baroni and Vincenzo Italiano: across the previous seven, Baroni has two wins, Italiano three, with two draws.

Marco Baroni is the ex of the day: he played for Bologna in Serie B in 1991/92 and 1992/93, making 49 appearances and scoring three goals.

Cesare Casadei scored against Fiorentina: it was the Torino midfielder's third league goal of the season – all of them scored in 2026.



TORINO



BOLOGNA

Guillermo Maripán scored against Fiorentina: it was the Chilean defender's second league goal of the season. He had not scored in Serie A since 26 October 2025, in Torino-Genoa 2-1.



NAPOLI



ROMA

There are 90 official precedents between the two teams in Campania: record of 39 Napoli victories (latest 1-0, Serie A 2024/25), 26 draws (latest 2-2, Serie A 2023/24) and 25 Roma victories (latest 2-4, Serie A 2017/18).

Napoli scoring for 9 matches in a row at home against Roma: 16 Azzurri goals and last Neapolitan drought in the 0-0 of Serie A 2015/16.

Napoli coming off 6 matches in a row without a clean sheet: 11 goals conceded in the period. Last Azzurri clean sheet in the 1-0 against Sassuolo on 17 January 2026.

Napoli team of Serie A 2025/26 that concedes most penalties to opponents (7), like Milan.

Napoli team of Serie A 2025/26 that scores least with substitute players (1, like Udinese).

Roma one of the two teams of Serie A 2025/26 to not have conceded penalties (0, like Cagliari).

Roma team of Serie A 2025/26 with fewest goals conceded (14).

Between Antonio Conte and Gian Piero Gasperini 12th official encounter: in the 11 precedents, 7 victories for the first, 2 for the second and 2 draws.

Rasmus Hojlund on target against Genoa: 4th brace with Napoli, 5th seasonal considering the Danish national team. He had not scored a brace in official matches since 28 December 2025 (Cremonese-Napoli 0-2, Serie A). These are the first goals scored in the calendar year 2026 in Serie A.

Antonio Arena is the first player born in 2009 to debut in Serie A: he came on at 84' of Roma-Cagliari 2-0 last 9 February.

Donyell Malen on target against Cagliari: first brace in Serie A for the Dutch striker. He had not scored one in official matches since 27 November 2025 (Aston Villa-Young Boys 2-1, Europa League).

Mile Svilar has collected his 24th appearance from the start out of 24 in this championship. Starter for 77 consecutive matches in Serie A, starting from the 25th matchday of the 2023/24 tournament (Frosinone-Roma 0-3, 18/02/2024).



CAGLIARI



LECCE

There have been 21 official meetings in Cagliari between the two sides: Cagliari have won seven (most recently 4-1 in Serie A 2024/25), there have been nine draws (most recently 1-1 in Serie A 2023/24) and Lecce have won five (most recently 2-1 in Serie A 2011/12).

Cagliari have kept a home clean sheet for 220 minutes: the last goal they conceded at home was scored by Leão in the 50th minute of Cagliari-Milan 0-1 on 2 January 2026.

Cagliari are the Serie A 2025/26 team with the fewest penalties taken (1).

Cagliari are among the teams with the most different goalscorers in Serie A 2025/26 (16), level with Juventus and Inter.

Cagliari are the top team in Serie A 2025/26 for goals scored by substitutes (7).

Cagliari are one of two Serie A 2025/26 teams yet to concede a penalty (0), level with Roma.

Cagliari are among the teams yet to receive a red card in Serie A 2025/26, like Inter and Torino.

Lecce are among the teams that have benefited from the fewest opposition red cards (0), level with Milan, Sassuolo, Verona and Torino.

Lecce are the lowest-scoring team in Serie A 2025/26 with 15 goals.

Lecce have gone 315 minutes without scoring away from home: their last away goal was scored by Banda in the 45th minute of Juventus-Lecce 1-1 on 3 January 2026.

It will be the second official meeting between Fabio Pisacane and Eusebio Di Francesco: Pisacane's side won 2-0 away at the Via del Mare in the reverse fixture.

Only Idrissa Touré (118) and Victor Nelsson (102) have won more aerial duels than Tiago Gabriel (100) in Serie A 2025/26.

Only Manuel Locatelli (49) and Mandela Keita (48) have won more tackles than Santiago Pierotti (47, level with Morten Frendrup) in Serie A 2025/26. The Argentine also ranks third for tackles attempted (85), behind Antoine Bernede (86) and Morten Frendrup (89).
